# MALAYSIA HAS RNJ3 BIL IPO PIPELINE IN 2H22 - MAYBANK IB

ccording to Maybank Investment Bank (Maybank IB) chief executive officer Datuk Fad'l Mohamed, the Malaysian initial public offering (IPO) pipeline in 2H22 is valued at around RM3 billion. Across the wider equity capital market (ECM), the investment bank is also seeing some traction in the merger and acquisition (M&A) and private equity (PE) space. He was speaking at a press conference in conjunction with Maybank Invest Asean 2022 conference. There are still a lot of deal activities happening in the market. There is a strong ECM pipeline coming through, year to date with around nine IPOs. Going forward in 2H22, he is seeing a total deal value of about RM3 billion on ECM coming through in sectors like consumer, retail, general industrial, TMT (technology, media and telecommunications) and transport and logistics. On the M&A side, there is a lot of restructuring activities particularly among some of the GLCs and GLICs. There is also a lot of traction on the PE space, with buy-sell opportunities coming in, and also in-country consolidation. Meanwhile, the local debt capital market (DCM) has also remained stable with a full-year outlook of RM110 billion. This compares with RM114 billion recorded in 2021, according to

Securities Commission Malaysia's data. On DCM, he sees a potential of RM6.8 billion coming up in 2H22, and potential ESG-linked alone is over RM6 billion. The investment bank has completed 33 issuances totalling RM6.3 billion, of which sustainability issuance alone is RM2.1 billion. On sustainability-linked instruments, the investment bank is seeing opportunities for key projects that fall within the category, coupled with ample liquidity looking for such green assets. The other aspect is for some companies looking at transitioning, sustainability-tied instruments. Attractive proposition for a lot of clients to raise capital with clear targets in terms of the pathway of ESG. And on the demand side, a lot of investors are looking at this asset class, and continue to have a strong appetite to take up ESG-related papers, sustainability-tied instruments. With economic recovery, with refinancing of large maturities coming through this year and next, the environment is definitely conducive for capital raising.

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# MALAYSIA 2H EQUITIES OUTLOOK HINGES ON GLOBAL RISK APPETITE - HSBC

According to HSBC global private banking and wealth Southeast Asia chief investment officer James Cheo, the Malaysian equities market outlook in 2H22 is likely to depend heavily on global appetite for risk assets, with selective investment opportunities in beneficiaries of economic reopening and commodities sectors. The bank is currently neutral on Malaysia equities, which are really tied in to the general risk sentiment in the global economy, and at this stage the risk appetite in the world economy is still very fragile. Speaking at the HSBC 2H22 Investment Outlook briefing, he said the market may reassess the Malaysian market again when there is a more concrete kind of improvement in the global dynamics, particularly on how the recovery is in the picture of inflation. He acknowledged that Malaysia is on a "fairly solid" growth path given the Southeast Asian nation's well-diversified export base from crude oil, palm oil as well as playing a prominent role in the global semiconductor supply chain. Malaysia's economy grew 5% in the first quarter of this year thanks to improvements in labour market, domes-

tic and external demand amid easing pandemic restrictions. This came after a 3.1% gross domestic product (GDP) growth last year. Malaysia's GDP is expected to grow 5.5% this year thanks to tailwinds from improving manufacturing activities and favourable commodities prices. This has taken into account an expectation for another 50 basis points overnight policy rate hike this year, with Bank Negara Malaysia potentially ending 2022 with a benchmark interest rate of 2.5%. In terms of foreign exchange outlook, while the ringgit has endured high volatility in 1H22, the domestic currency will likely stabilise in 2H22 and trade around 4.2800 against the US dollar by end of this year. With the impact of pandemic restrictions receding and reopening of the economy, private consumption is going to bounce back, investments are likely to also be quite robust. Therefore, there are several selective investment opportunities, particularly in sectors associated with reopening, consumption, banking, commodities and semiconductor. Although the bank's outlook is neutral on Malaysian equities, there are selective opportunities, because various parts of the economy are actually doing very well.

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# FOREIGN FUNDS PURCHASE RM477.5MIL NET OF LOCAL EQUITIES - MIDF


According to MIDF research data, the foreign inflow turned positive on Bursa Malaysia for the week ended June 3, 2022 with net purchases of RM477.5mil. This was in line with the swing to a positive inflow in Asian markets after eight weeks of net outflow. This was owing to the US dollar index (DXY) losing appeal as forecasts of the US nonfarm payrolls were trimmed vigorously. Based on the provisional aggregate data for the seven Asian exchanges that MIDF tracks, investors classified as "foreign" bought US\$2.3bil last week. On the local bourse, net buying from foreign investors was recorded from Monday to Wednesday. The heaviest net inflow came on Tuesday with RM320.8mil net of local equities bought by foreigners. Meanwhile, local retailers remained net sellers with a net outflow of RM121.4mil. Local institutions were net sellers for a fourth consecutive week to the tune


of RM356.1mil. In terms of participation, all investor classes except for local retailers showed an improvement for the week. Foreign investors and local institutions saw an increase in the average daily trade value (ADTV) by 110.3% and +24% respectively. Meanwhile, local retailers posted a decline of 2.5% in ADTV.

This week, on Friday (10June), the Ringgit opened at 4.3990 against the USD from 4.3975 on Tuesday (7June). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1849 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (10June). 

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fter cutting the global GDP growth estimate to 3.2% in April from 4.1% in January, the World Bank was in the news again this week as it slashed the growth estimates yet again, this time to 2.9%, as "the world economy is again in danger". In its Global Economic Prospect report this week, the World Bank President, David Malpass, warned of above-average inflation and below-average growth ahead and this could have a devastating impact on low and middle-income economies. As stagflation fears grow, the World Bank calls for supply disruption to be addressed aggressively to tackle high inflation prints. The World Bank now sees US GDP growth at just 2.5% from 3.7% previously while China and the Euro-area will see a growth of 4.3% and 2.5% respectively. The Russian invasion of Ukraine will see Moscow paying a heavy economic price as its economy is set to contract 8.9% this year while Ukraine will see a steep 45.1% plunge in its GDP this year. In a related development, the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) too cut the 2022 global economic growth forecast to just 3.0% from 4.5% previously and reduced growth in 2023 to 2.8% from 3.2% estimated earlier.

it is not all gloomy on the economic front as the J.P.Morgan Global Composite Output Index for May improved marginally to 51.5 from 51.2 as the opening up of China's lockdown measures helped to boost the rate of expansion. However, the S&P Global Eurozone Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) Composite Output Index for May dropped to 54.8 from 55.8 in April. The US labour market report was a mixed bag as Non-Farm Payrolls came in at 290,000, ahead of market estimates of 325,000 but well below the preceding month's revised 436,000 jobs. The unemployment rate stayed flat at 3.6%, while Average Hourly Earnings grew 5.2% y-o-y from the 5.5% in April. In other key US economic data, the Institute of Supply Management (ISM) Services PMI for May fell to 55.9 against the market forecast of a 56.4 print and 57.1 in April.

Out of China, external trade figures for May were relatively decent as exports grew 16.9% y-o-y while imports expanded by 4.1%, both beating market expectations of an 8% and 2% growth respectively.

Up north, Thailand's Consumer Price Index (CPI) for May went up to another level as headline inflation surged to a 14-year high, rising by 7.1% y-o-y from 4.6% in April. However, core inflation rose at a more modest pace, rising by 2.3% y-o-y against 2.0% y-o-y growth in the preceding month. The higher inflation print also prompted the Bank of Thailand (BoT) to raise its inflation forecast to 6.2% for the year, while the GDP forecast was revised to 3.3% from 3.2%. Meanwhile, the BoT maintained the key benchmark policy rate at 0.5% but warned that the current low rates are no longer necessary given the upside of the economy and inflationary threat. The Philippines too saw higher inflation print as the headline inflation rate rose to 5.4% y-o-y in May from 4.9% in April. Downunder, the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) accelerated the pace of rate hike as it moved the benchmark Cash Rate by 50bps to 0.85%, a move that surprised the market.

Locally, Malaysia's international reserves as at May 31, 2022, rose by US\$1.4bil to US\$112.8bil. In Ringgit terms, reserves improved by RM6.11bil to RM474.22bil from RM468.11bil as at May 13, 2022. Meanwhile, RM0.5bil net foreign inflow into the fixed income market

was recorded last month, reversing the net outflow of RM6.2bil over the past two months. In other news, Malaysia is expected to table the long-awaited Fiscal Responsibility Bill at the upcoming Parliament session. Once passed, the Fiscal Responsibility Act (FRA) will allow the government to broaden the current tax base, which includes measures to tax the shadow economy, better tax compliance, and administration to boost the nation's coffers. In a related development, the Deputy Secretary-General of the Treasury announced that there will be no new taxes, including the reintroduction of the Goods and Service Tax (GST) until the economy is firmly on track.

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In economic data, Malaysia's April unemployment rate dipped to 3.9% as the number of employed persons increased by 84,100 to 15.85mil from 15.77mil in March, while the number of unemployed persons declined by 19,900 to 649.300 from 669,200 in the preceding month. Other economic data released this week showed a strong performance in the Wholesale and Retail Trade as sales valued surged 15.2% y-o-y to RM128bil. Retail Trade jumped 20.9% y-o-y to RM53.6bil, while Wholesale Trade and Motor Vehicles posted 11.5% and 11.3% growth y-o-y to RM59bil and RM15.4bil respectively.

Fraser & Neave Holdings announced plans to take its associate company Cocoaland Holdings private in a deal worth some RM488.2mil or RM1.50 per share. In other news, IHH Healthcare took steps to monetise its investment in IMU Health SB, the owner of IMU Education, IMC Education, and IMU Healthcare, with the sale of the company to Inbound Education Holdings SB for RM1.24bil cash. In addition, IHH Healthcare is also selling a hospital that is currently under construction to Columbia Asia SB for a net consideration of RM101mil.

Meanwhile, CapitaLand Malaysia Trust is moving away from its traditional stronghold in retail assets by acquiring two plots of industrial properties with some 335,000 square feet of net lettable area located at Sungai Jawi, Penang for RM80mil. Dialog was also in the news this week as it acquired a 100% stake in Pacific Orient Energy Corporation

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for US\$38.7mil or RM170.3mil, which has a 50.01% stake in a production upstream onshore oil field in Thailand.

Following the finalization of the proposed disposal of highway assets, Gamuda announced plans to distribute RM1bil or 39.16 sen per share as a special dividend while Litrak intends to distribute RM2.71bil from the sale of its assets, translating to RM5.08 per share. Litrak has informed the Exchange that it does not intend to maintain its listing status, post disposal of its highway assets.

# EQUITY

Global markets were generally mixed over the past week as investors weigh on the latest economic data points, a spike in crude oil price, which surged passed the US\$120 per barrel mark, and rising treasury yield as the 10-year US treasuries breached the 3.00% mark. Markets that rose gained between 0.3% to as much as 3.7% on the Hang Seng Index, while markets that fell witnessed losses of between 0.3% and 2.6%. Over on Bursa Malaysia, the market closed broadly lower with KLCI losing 40.19 pts or 2.6% to 1,509.71 pts – its lowest close since January 25, 2022, on the back of sustained selling pressure among key index stocks.

For the holiday-shortened week ended June 8, local institutions and retail market participants turned net buyers with an inflow of RM94.2mil and RM47.1mil, while foreigners were net sellers with an outflow of RM141.3mil.

# EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the Industrial Production Index (IPI) as well as the Monthly Manufacturing statistics for April 2022. China will be releasing the key CPI and Producer Price Index (PPI) data for May, while the US will be issuing the May headline and core inflation prints, which are expected to come in at 8.3% and 5.9% respectively. The June preliminary University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment Index is also due today, with the market looking at a reading of 58 from 58.4 in May.

On Tuesday, June 14, the US will be releasing the May PPI, which consensus expects a 10.7% y-o-y increase from the 11% recorded in April. On Wednesday, June 15, attention will shift to China as the world's second-largest economy will be releasing the May data for Retail Sales, which is expected to show a drop of 6.1% y-o-y, Industrial Production, which is estimated to improve by 0.4% y-o-y and the cumulative Fixed Asset Investments, which is expected to increase by 7%. Out of the US, the May Retail Sales will be out with the market looking at a modest 0.2% m-o-m increase,

On the same day, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) is expected to announce a 50bps hike in the US Fed Fund Rate. The FOMC will also be releasing fresh economic projections for the US, while its press conference and monetary policy statement will be greatly scrutinized by the market. Another key economic data point is Malaysia's May External Trade Statistics, which is due on Thursday, June 17.

# WHY THE DELAY OF 11 DAYS IN ANNOUNCING A LEGAL SUIT?

Chief Executive Officer, Minority Shareholders Watch Group echnical rubber compound specialist GIIB Holdings Berhad (formerly Goodway Integrated Industries Berhad) owes an explanation to its minority shareholders as to why it took the company "a good 11 days" to make public that it has been served with an originating summons (OS) by its former executive director Wong Weng Yew. While Wong, who is also a shareholder of GIIB with a 6% stake, had filed his OS with the Shah Alam High Court on 19 May via his solicitors, Messrs Chong + Kheng Hoe, GIIB has only made known of the legal suit via a Bursa Malaysia filing on 30 May under the subject "Material Litigation".

Doubtlessly, the long delay in disclosing the legal suit filed by Wong – who coincidentally had his services terminated on the same day – is a sure breach of the core corporate governance principle

of transparency and the need for timely information to enable minority shareholders to make informed investment decisions. The common practice would have been for GIIB to immediately make a Bursa Malaysia announcement that a legal action has been initiated against the company or at the very least the next day if the OS was received after office hours. Besides, this brought to question of whether GIIB had breached the Main Market Listing Requirements (MMLR) which require a listed issuer to make immediate public disclosure of any material information including "the commencement of or the involvement in litigation and any material development arising from such litigation" (Paragraph 9.04 (f) of MMLR).

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To recap, Wong who was suspended on grounds of misconduct as per the charges made against him in a show cause letter dated 28 March this year, has had his services terminated after the company's external independent auditor claimed to have found sufficient basis to hold him accountable for misconduct. He was then re-designated as GIIB's nonindependent non-executive director on 27 May upon termination of his employment.

According to GIIB's Annual Report 2020, Wong was appointed as an executive director of GIIB on 23 February last year when he was made responsible for managing the group's finance and accounting operations. Prior to joining GIIB, he was attached to PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP in Singapore where he managed and provided advisory for business processes, IT auditing and security review. Overall, he has more than 10 years' experience in business advisory and auditing. Recall that Wong had on 25 April lodged a police report in respect of the contentious matters involving GIIB. He claimed he had yet to receive update on the matter of the investigative committee set up by GIIB. Furthermore, he voiced his concern on poor governance as a member of the investigative committee is a family member of GIIB's executive chairman, Tai Boon Wee.

# WHAT DOES THE OS SEEK?

In a nutshell, the OS has named as defendants the company, its executive chairman Tai Boon Wee, executive/alternate director Tai Qiyao (who has ceased to be the alternate director to Tai Boon Wee with effect from 1 June), fellow executive director Tai Qisheng and nonindependent non-executive director Madam Wong Ping Kiong.

As per GIIB's Bursa Malaysia filing dated 30 May, the following were sought from the directors named as defendants in Wong's OS:

- A declaration of a breach of Main Market Listing Requirements (MMLR)
- Indemnity against the plaintiff (Wong) on any and/or liabilities, costs and damages arising from the breach of MMLR
- An injunction as director and/or officer of GIIB and its subsidiaries for a period of five years
- A restraint from managing GIIB and its subsidiaries for a period of five years
- A restriction from buying GIIB shares for a period of five years
- A restriction from on voting or any other rights in relation to GIIB's shares
- A restriction on collecting and issuance of new GIIB shares through a private placement exercise

From GIIB and the directors named in person as defendants, the following were sought by the OS:

- Any other relief under Section 360 of the Capital Markets and Services Act 2007;
- General damages determined by the court
- Exemplary damages
- Aggravated damages
- A declaration that the plaintiff's (Wong) suspension as an executive director is considered null and void

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- A restraint from imposing a restriction on the plaintiff (Wong) to the access of information, documents, records and premise of GIIB
- Any other ruling deemed fit by the court under Section 346(2) of the Companies Act 2016
- Costs of application and other costs
- Interests
- Any other relief deem fit by the court

While the announcement on the OS offered little details to public, a news report by online media Focus Malaysia on 27 May probably helped to shed some light on the events which led to this corporate saga. It was reported that Wong has in his OS disputed the reasons given by GIIB to change its financial year end to 30 June 2022 from 31 December 2021 (which was announced on 27 April 2022). GIIB said the change of financial year was supposed to facilitate the investigation into its management, the handling of the glove business as well as the accounts of the company and its subsidiaries (which is linked to Wong's suspension and ultimately termination). Claiming this reasoning as falsehood, Wong alleged that GIIB's auditor Grant Thornton Malaysia PLT had in fact issued a disclaimer of opinion in its draft audited accounts of the company that it has not been able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion on these financial statements. Based on the previous financial year end of 31 December 2021, GIIB would have required to file its Annual Report 2021 and audited financial statements for its financial on or before 30 April 2022. If the disclaimer by the auditor is made public, GIIB would have triggered a Practice Note 17 (PN17) situation. However, with the change of its financial year-end from 31 December 2021 to 30 June 2022, GIIB only must announce the audited financial statements on or before 31 October 2022.

All in all, it seems that the storms in GIIB is far from over.

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
