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Kuala Lumpur among top 10 cities in Asia Pacific seen as leading technology innovation hub — KPMG

According to Guy Edwards, head of technology, media and telecommunications sector at KPMG in Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur is ranked the ninth top city in the Asia Pacific and outside of Silicon Valley/San Francisco as a leading technology innovation hub over the next four years. In its global Technology Industry Survey 2021 involving more than 800 industry leaders, this was based on several factors both at a local level such as infrastructure and demographics and at a macro level such as the regulatory environment and potential national tax incentives. This is not all that surprising considering several studies have already recognised and identified factors that make Malaysia an attractive investment opportunity. There is definitely continued global confidence in the country's potential as a development hotbed, thanks to the Malaysian government's dedication to advance the country's technology infrastructure with the introduction of initiatives such as the National Fourth Industrial Revolution policy. While government impetus could be just the thing to amplify Malaysia's potential as a tech hub, more is needed beyond simply introducing newer policies. The survey showed that 61% of industry insiders believed the pandemic has changed their opinions of which cities would become leading technology innovation hubs. Only one third feel that Silicon Valley will maintain its innovation leadership position, while an equal number feel it will not.

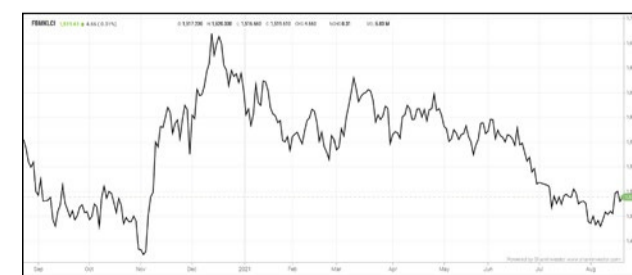
Agri-commodities export jumps 65% in second quarter

According to Minister of Plantation Industries and Commodities (MPIC) Datuk Dr Mohd Khairuddin Aman Razali, agri-commodities and agri-commodities product exports jumped 65% to RM105bil in the second quarter of 2021 from RM64bil in the same period last year. As of June this year, palm oil-based products which were the biggest contributor with 43% of the total agri-commodities export, increased to RM46bil compared to RM33bil in the first six months last year. However, palm oil based products export quantity declined 5% to 11.5 million

tonnes. Covid-19 pandemic continuously impacted palm oil production and exports not only in Malaysia but also other global palm oil producing countries. The implementation of the movement control order by the government up to the National Recovery Programme on a scheduled basis over the past six months has directly impacted the export of palm oil and agri-commodity-based products. Following the encouraging performance, he is optimistic that the RM75bil palm oil export target this year could be achieved even though the country is still facing a shortage of workers in oil palm plantations. Meanwhile, rubber products that contributed 42% of the total agri-commodities export recorded a surge of 150% to RM44bil from RM17.77bil in the same period last year. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the value of latex-based products export such as rubber gloves and others rose 200% to RM37bil from RM12bil in the same period in 2020. Rubber gloves that are mainly for medical uses recorded more than threefold growth or 210%. On the other hand, wood-based products contributed 11% to agri-commodities export, increasing 21% to RM12bil from RM10bil in the same period 2020. Cocoa-based products export also posted an increase of 7% to RM3.4bil compared with RM3.1bil previously and pepper-based products export climbed 19.24% to RM62mil from RM52mil in the same period 2020.

This week, on Friday (20Aug), the Ringgit opened 4.2375 against the USD from 4.2420 on Monday (16Aug). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1063 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (20Aug). On Monday (16Aug), the FBM KLCI opened at 1499.92. As at Friday (20Aug) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is up 19.28 points for the week at 1519.20. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 66.57 points (-0.19%) to 34,894.12 whilst the NASDAQ added 15.90 points (+0.11%) to 14,541.80.

Based on the weekly chart for UnUsUaL, its share price has been consolidating between August 2020 and November 2020. This can be seen from the tightening of the Bollinger Band. Subsequently, its share price experienced a breakout, accompanied by high trading volume and the MACD line punching above zero. This is a sign of a bullish setup.

By Mid-January 2021, UnUsUaL's share price experienced some profit taking, but was able to rebound from the 20-Day Moving Average. Meanwhile, another strong breakout occurred in March 2021, whereby it displayed a bullish candlestick and breaching the upper limit of the Bollinger Band.

Since then, UnUsUaL's share price has been trending lower, given the decreasing volume, MACD line and the share price is trading below the 20-Day Moving Average.

In the latest trading week, it shows a long wick candlestick, which indicates strong support and the potential turnaround in the share price's trend. Furthermore, the candlestick pattern highlights that its share price is trying to build a bottom, pending for a potential reversal.

Lastly, the next resistance level will be around S\$0.18, which is the 20-Day Moving Average. On the other hand, investors will have to take note if its share price continued to breach the lower limit of the Bollinger Band, which could indicate further weakness in the share price.

It's A Numbers Game

Markets

The market's focus this week was the release of the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) meeting minutes which revealed the Fed's plan to start its tapering program as early as later part of this year as the Fed sees improvement in the unemployment rate while core personal consumption expenditure is expected to ease further. The US Dollar rose to its highest level in more than nine months while Chinese tech stocks took a beating, following market fears of further regulatory controls especially on tech giants and online gaming. Early this week, attention was also focused on Afghanistan following the fall of Kabul to the Taliban, as the Americans fled after 20 years of occupancy. Investors were re-assessing the geopolitical risk following the US withdrawal and its role in managing international affairs.

Economy

Out of the US, the Producer Price Index (PPI) that was released last Thursday showed pricing pressure is rising as the July indicator jumped 7.8% y-o-y, the highest in 11 years. Preliminary data from the University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment Index fell to just 70.2 in the first half of August, which is the lowest point in 11 years, from July's final reading of 81.2. Another gauge too showed slowing momentum as July retail sales fell by 1.1% m-o-m, worse than the market's forecast of a 0.3% decline. In other news, US housing data came in relatively weak as July housing starts declined by 7% to an annualized rate of 1.534mil units.

The Euro Area and Japan also released their respective 2Q GDP data this week. The Japanese economy expanded by an annualized rate of 1.3% for the quarter, beating market expectations of a 0.7% gain, while the Euro Area's second estimate for the 2Q period came in a 0.1 percentage pts lower than the previously reported growth of 13.7% y-o-y.

Out of China, three key barometers came in below expectations this week. July Industrial production showed a y-o-y increase of just 6.4%, slower than the 8.3% y-o-y growth in June and consensus estimate of a 7.9% y-o-y gain. Retail sales improved by just 8.5% y-o-y from the preceding month's 12.1% y-o-y rise

and market expectations of a 10.9% y-o-y gain. In addition, the cumulative fixed-asset investment for the first seven months is now at 10.3% y-o-y against the cumulative first six months' gain of an increase of 12.6% y-o-y.

Locally, following the release of the 2Q GDP data point last Friday, Malaysia has now officially revised its GDP growth estimate for the year to just between 3% and 4% from the earlier guidance of between 6% and 7.5%. Following the 2Q GDP report card, Fitch Solutions revised Malaysia's GDP growth this year to zero, citing Malaysia's high number of Covid-19 cases as its main reason and in their view that Malaysia will not achieve herd immunity before the end of the year, despite the accelerated pace of vaccine rollout. S&P Global Ratings too lowered their GDP forecast for Malaysia to 3.2% from the earlier forecast of 4.1% as it sees weakening domestic demand as a result of an extended lockdown period.

In other economic news, July vehicle sales fell by 88% to just 7,086 units, bringing the year-to-date total industry volume to 256,215 units, up 10.2% y-o-y from last year's total of 232,423 units for the same period.

Meanwhile, Thailand was the latest to provide its 2Q GDP data and the kingdom reported GDP growth of 7.5% y-o-y. The National Economic and Social Development Council (NESDC) lowered its full-year forecast to just between 0.7% and 1.2%, from an earlier forecast of between 1.5-2.5% in May. Down south, Singapore reported its July external data which showed non-oil domestic exports rising by another 12.7% y-o-y, while Indonesia's exports for the same month rose by 29.3% y-o-y. In other news, Indonesia left its key benchmark rates unchanged as the central bank remained committed to supporting the domestic economy.

Corporate

WCT Holdings proposed to dispose of 12 pieces of vacant freehold lands to MDCon (Simpang Empat) Sdn. Bhd. for RM214.3mil or RM8.89psf based on net land area. The lands, located at Mukim of Serendah, Daerah Ulu Selangor, have a combined gross area of 604.5 acres and a net land area of 553.5 acres. The cash sale will see WCT recognizing a gain of RM45.5mil from the disposal of the said lands. In other corporate activities, Boustead Holdings has agreed to

dispose of its 66.4% stake held in University of Nottingham Malaysia for £23.5mil or RM137.4mil to the University of Nottingham, UK. Boustead will recognize a net gain of RM7.6mil from the cash sale. Corporate results released this week were strong, especially from plantation companies. KL Kepong reported a 3Q core net profit of RM451.6mil, up 168.4% y-o-y and 41.2% q-o-q while Sime Darby Plantations reported core net earnings of RM617mil, up 63.2% y-o-y and 9.8% q-o-q.

Equity

Global equity markets were mostly lower on market concerns on further regulatory controls on tech companies and Fed's taper plans. Markets that fell saw losses of between 0.4% and as much as 4.9% on the Taiwan Stock Exchange Weighted Index. Markets that buck the trend rose by between 0.9% and 2.5%. Shares on Bursa Malaysia were firmer, with the KLCI closing on Thursday at 1,514.95 pts, up 12.98 pts for the week.

For the week ended August 18th, after a long while, foreigners turned net buyers with a net inflow of RM154.7mil while local retailers sustained their net buying position with an inflow of RM159mil. With that, local institutions were the only net sellers in the market with an outflow of RM313.7mil.

Eye On Week Ahead

The August Flash IHS Markit Eurozone Composite Index will be out on Monday. On the same day, the US will be releasing Existing Home Sales data for July followed by New Home Sales the next day. The consensus estimate for these two data is at an annualized rate of 5.84mil and 0.7mil respectively. US Durable Goods Order is expected to be released on Wednesday with the market looking at a 0.4% decline on a month-to-month basis. The second estimate of the US 2Q GDP data, which was previously announced at 6.5% y-o-y, will be out on Thursday.

Locally, Malaysia will be releasing the international reserves position as at end of July later today. Next week, key data include the July Consumer Price Index and the Producer Price Index, which will be released on Wednesday and Thursday respectively.

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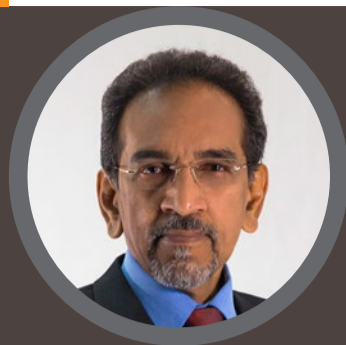

Independent directors – the last bastion of hope for minority shareholders

Under the Companies Act 2016, all directors owe a fiduciary duty to act in the best interest of the company. However, the Bursa Securities Listing Requirements (LR) take a more pragmatic approach by distinguishing independent directors (IDs) from non-independent directors. Independent directors are classified as independent non-executive directors (INEDs) while non-independent directors are classified as either non-independent non-executive directors (NINEDs) or executive directors (EDs). A Non-independent director who has no executive capacity is a NINED. The non-independent directors are deemed so under the LR for a few reasons e.g., they are holding more than 5% shares, they are EDs, they are nominee directors, they are 'related' to each other. In each of these instances, it is obvious that they may face challenges to their independence. Though they can be independent, the LR is being objective by classifying them as non-independent directors. It therefore becomes obvious why minority shareholders place a lot of hope and trust on IDs and why they are considered the last bastion of hope at the corporate level.

Major shareholders elect IDs – a paradox

Major shareholders can elect IDs – unlike an RPT, where interested directors cannot vote. Thus, shareholders who hold more than 50% stake in a company can elect IDs of their choice. And obviously, there may be a temptation for these shareholders to appoint friendly parties or subservient parties as IDs. Minority shareholders cannot do much in such instance even when the elected IDs are evidently 'friendly parties' or 'connected' in some way as they have not breached the definition of IDs. These so-called IDs fulfil the definition of IDs in form but not in substance. The most the minority shareholders can do is to question the Board and the Nomination Committee during annual general meeting. This is the first red flag for minority shareholders – is the independence of the ID questionable?

Remuneration impacting independence

Sometimes, IDs are handsomely remunerated in exchange for their allegiance and patronage. These IDs are heavily dependent on the remuneration to the extent that they become dependent in substance while fulfilling the definition of IDs in form. In fact, a true ID is one who is prepared to walk away from the remuneration if he senses something is not right – the ID is not dependent on the remuneration to balance his financial position.

ID resigns mid-tenure may be a red flag

Another red flag is the reaction of IDs, if any, when issues surface and how soon they react when these issues surface. These will be the tell-tale signs for minority shareholders when making informed investment decisions. Every ID has his own risk threshold, which will trigger his resignation and whistleblowing when problems arise in a company. We have seen this in the corporate circles where some IDs resign at the first signs of trouble while others, due to their risk appetite, stay on and resign at later stages as the problems fester to varying degrees. Minority shareholders, as investors, must perform their due diligence on the background and track record of IDs sitting at the Board of PLCs. Prominent and reputable directors are of some comfort but is not an absolute guarantee. Angels who walk on to boards may turn out to be devils. Perhaps, continued due diligence is the order of the day when evaluating IDs.

Multiple Resignations

Multiple resignations from the board, at any one time or consecutively in short interval is another wake-up call especially when it involves IDs. The inference is that perhaps all is not well in the company and these directors want out before things blow up. This may be an attempt to avoid regulatory sanctions. Resigning directors often cite boiler-plate reasons such as 'pursuing other interests' as the reason for their resignation. Maybe, they do not want to burn their bridges by

stating the actual reason. However, minority shareholders and the stock market are often able to read between the lines and draw their own inference. There are a few instances where the directors have the integrity to state the actual reason as to why they are resigning. Such resignations are surely another red flag to be considered by minority shareholders.

The three disciplines of good CG

The best discipline is to have self-discipline. There are companies, even those with major shareholders, which end up with IDs perceived by the market as independent. Both the major shareholder and the company has exercised the self-discipline to ensure this. And if there is no self-discipline, the market will step in to discipline the PLC. Where the market perceives that something is amiss, whether in the appointment of IDs or in their resignation, the market disciplines these PLCs by 'sell-downs' of the shares, both by institutional shareholders and even minority shareholders. This can be quite painful, not only in terms of share price reaction, but also by damage to reputation which is easy to lose and hard to regain. The third discipline is regulatory discipline whereby the regulators will impose their sanctions on the PLC and/or directors in their personal capacity.

Conclusion

Minority shareholders must do their due diligence, not only on the PLC, but also on the directors of the PLC, especially the IDs who are the last bastion of hope for minority shareholders. We all know that the company is a legal person devoid of emotions – it is the directors who manage the company. Since, it is the directors, under whose directions the company operates, it makes absolute sense to spend some time performing due diligence on the directors, especially the IDs.

It is said that there are 2 types of IDs – independent directors and independent 'independent directors'-minority shareholders prefer the latter.
