

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# Prosperity Tax a one-off measure - Tengku Zafrul

ccording to Finance Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz, the Prosperity Tax is a one-off tax measure amid analysts' fear of its reintroduction in the future. In reiterating, he added that it would not impact more than 250 companies - only companies with more than RM100 million in chargeable income would be taxed. The Prosperity Tax is one-off in this extraordinary time and it will be implemented in that spirit. It will be used to ensure the public health system is more resilient in the face of any threat in the future. Speaking at the Invest Malaysia 2021 Series 2 virtual event, he said that several large corporations have stated that the Prosperity Tax will not affect their dividend payments, citing Telekom Malaysia, Tenaga Nasional and Axiata that have supported the effort. There are more than 900 listed companies on Bursa Malaysia, of which 145 made over RM100 million in their financial year 2019. But in the financial year 2020, only 125 listed companies earned more than RM100 million. According to Bloomberg data, only 130 companies achieved the same pre-tax earnings level across the last two financial years. It is a very small number of companies on the stock exchange. Different countries have decided to permanently increase their taxes in the future as they recover from the Covid-19. For example, in the UK, corporate tax is increased permanently. Saudi and Indonesia have increased value added tax (VAT). In the medium term, the government is considering options to reduce the reliance on direct taxes and to widen the revenue base including shifting to a consumption tax base. There will be more discussion on this when the Fiscal Responsibility Act is tabled next year which will cover the medium-term revenue strategy and outline the stages of revenue measures. We want to review tax legislation and modernise revenue administration. The Prosperity Tax certainly does not fall in that spirit. More reliable consumption tax will be explored as new taxation revenues such as taxation on the digital economy. As part of the 12th Malaysia Plan, the government is now looking into imposing the carbon tax. The finance ministry is working with the environment and water ministry on the imposition of the carbon tax, adding that the government will continue to assess

the entire revenue ecosystem.


According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia Chief Statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Malaysia's e-commerce income surged to RM279.0 billion, a jump of 17.1% year-on-year, in Q3 of 2021. Commenting on the Malaysia Digital Economy 2021 report, he said that in terms of quarter-onquarter growth, it maintained a positive trend of 4.3%. From January to September, e-commerce income recorded RM801.2 billion, an increase of 23.1% y-o-y. E-commerce was driven by industrial centres such as Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Johor, and Penang. In terms of industry, manufacturing and services remained the key drivers of growth. The improved performance was attributed to the adoption of new normal during the Covid-19 pandemic, in which it boosted digital usage in Malaysia. On e-commerce income by market segment in 2019, the local sector dominated with a contribution of 87.6%, generated from sales in Malaysia, compared with the international sector's 12.4%. The value of the income generated was RM591.8 billion and RM83.5 billion, respectively. E-commerce income by type of customers via business-to-business registered the highest income of RM449.6 billion with a 66.6% contribution, followed by business-to-consumer at RM194.0 billion, or 28.7%. In the meantime, businessto-government recorded RM31.8 billion (4.7%) adding that digital technology has the potential to propel Malaysia's economic growth. The Malaysia Digital Economy Blueprint (MyDigital), which was launched by the government in February 2021, is the foundation for the country's transformation into a "regional digital pulse" which is expected to boost productivity, stimulate innovation, and improve livelihoods by harnessing the internet, Big Data, the Internet of Things, artificial intelligence, and other technologies.

#### Malaysian healthcare sector to benefit from progressive reforms - Fitch Solutions

According to Fitch Solutions Country Risk & Industry Research, the spread of the Delta variant had stretched the healthcare system in Malaysia. It said that Malaysian hospitals were overstretched, while Covid-19 bed utilisation was consistently beyond 100% during its peak in August 2021, leading to the construction of field hospitals. As the virus now progresses from the pandemic to endemic stage, Malaysia aims to invest in regional disease centres, vaccine development and develop better understanding of communicable diseases. And, as the Covid-19 pandemic has shown, infectious diseases threaten a blow to health systems already facing significant pressure on their capacity to care for patients. Malaysia's public healthcare system is mainly financed through federal government taxation and general revenue. Although government spending on healthcare as a percentage of the country's gross domestic product had been gradually increasing over the years, the World Health Organization still considers this to be below global as well as regional standards. The pandemic had underscored the need to increase funding for the healthcare system both in terms of facilities and working conditions for staff. Citing Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz, it said Malaysia will undertake a medium-to long-term reform of its healthcare sector while gradually aiming to increase healthcare spending every year. Fitch Solutions added that among other policy directions being considered is increasing public healthcare charges for higherincome earners, and incentivising people to buy health insurance. Social protection schemes will also provide health benefits for informal workers. Moreover, looking beyond the pandemic, it believes that the Malaysian government will remain firmly committed to improving health quality and access across the country. Noting that in recent years, the healthcare sector has seen a rise in government expenditure, with an increase in medical facilities and higher-quality treatments. The implementation of the B40 healthcare scheme is one of the key initiatives that will expand healthcare access to the nation's lowest earners. In 2020, healthcare expenditure in Malaysia grew 6.9% year-on-year, with an estimated value of RM63.1 billion. In 2021, it's growth is expected to accelerate to 9.6%, reaching RM69.2 billion. It forecasts health expenditure to experience a fiveyear compound annual growth rate of 7.6% in local currency terms and 8.9% in US dollar terms, reaching RM91.1 billion by 2025. While reforms are under way to secure the long-term sustainability of the public healthcare system, challenges remain. Fitch Solution remains sceptical about the progress of the reforms and any alteration of the funding structure of the healthcare system will require a revision of its healthcare expenditure fvorecast. It will not incorporate this into their forecast until the reforms are officially approved and it notes that it is likely that the funding structure will change. Public healthcare expenditure will increase considerably in the short term. Its longerterm forecast reflects that the growth in spending will decelerate as cost-containment measures will inevitably be introduced to maintain sustainable levels of funding.

#### **Eye On The Markets**

This week, on Friday (12Nov), the Ringgit opened at 4.1675 against the USD from 4.1545 on Monday (08Nov). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0764 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (12Nov). On Monday (08Nov), the FBM KLCI opened at 1534.21. As at Friday (12Nov) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 6.46 points for the week at 1527.75. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 158.71 points (-0.44%) to 35,921.23 whilst the NASDAQ added 81.60 points (+0.52%) to 15,704.30.



**KLCI 1 Year Chart** 





## **Technical Analysis**

Since its IPO on 30 October 2020, its share price has been on an uptrend. With its share price trading above the upper limit of the Bollinger band in July 2021, this resulted in profit taking, accompanied by low volume traded across the week.

However, the profit taking took a turn for the worse as its share price faced a strong sell down in mid-august, with high volume and a big gap down. This was mainly due to the unexpected drop in earnings, which missed analysts' estimates by a wide margin.

Its share price recovered the following week with a series of share buybacks set to stabilize the share price's fluctuation. Despite that, it continued the downward trend, as seen from the MACD line, trading below the zero line.

Since then, its share price has been trading at a tight range of S\$3.70 and \$\$3.79. With RSI hovering around the mid-30s level, there could be a potential technical rebound for Nanofilm's share price.

For 1H FY2021, Nanofilm's revenue grew by 24.2% year-on-year to \$\$96.6 million. The growth is led by the Group's Advanced Materials Business Unit ("AMBU") and Industrial Equipment Business Unit ("IEBU").

Despite the top line growth, Nanofilm's net profit after tax suffered a decline of 2.3% year-on-year to S\$18.1 million. The trend was mainly dragged down by the increased start-up expenses related to the Group's new Shanghai Plant 2 and equipment qualification costs, as well as New Product Introduction ("NPI") projects.

As a result of the increase in operating costs, Nanofilm's PAT margin dropped by 5.1 percentage points to 18.7%.

Shortly after the release of its 1H FY2021 result on 13 August 2021, Nanofilm conducted a series of share buybacks to stabilize its share price. On 16 August 2021, they bought back 1.55 million shares at a price range of between \$\$4.21 and \$\$4.52. The transaction value amounted to \$\$6.76 million.

Subsequently, Nanofilm bought back another 3.36 million shares at a price range of between \$\$3.81 and \$\$4.07, to further stabilize its share price.

The latest share buyback transaction occurred on 14 October 2021, where the Group bought back 300,000 shares at a price range of between S\$3.68 and S\$3.76. The transaction value came in at S\$1.11 million.

#### Conclusion & Management Outlook

To conclude, Nanofilm's latest financial performance painted a mixed picture with top line growth but big decline in its bottom line due to the higher relevant costs involved.

On this note, analysts have slashed their forecasted figures and target price for Nanofilm. Despite the recent negativity, the CEO appointment and series of share buybacks may help stabilize its share price in the near term.

In terms of management outlook, Nanofilm mentioned that it will continue to leverage its core technologies on mission critical applications in new endmarkets that offer favourable secular growth trends and seek to tap strategic value chain partners to accelerate market penetration in these markets.

Finally, the Group will proactively seek potential synergistic acquisitions and strategic partnership, unlocking value through the Group's core technologies and platform.

# Keeping An Eye on "I"

#### **Markets**

Looks like Inflation is turning out to be more worrisome for markets than initially thought as sustained high readings suggest that central banks are under pressure to react from potential derailment in the growth trajectory of the global economy for 2022. Data this week saw both consumer and producer prices running hot and this is causing some nervousness among investors in both the equity and fixed income markets. This is also reflected in the 5-year US breakeven inflation rate, which hit a fresh record high of 3.08% on Wednesday after the headline October US Consumer Price Index (CPI) rose to 6.2% - the highest since 1990, while core CPI jumped by 4.6% y-o-y, a 30-year high. With the yield curve inversion between the 30-year and the 20-year bond, the market is now expecting a slower economic momentum as inflationary fears rise.

Locally, Fitch Solutions Country Risk and Industry Research estimates Malaysia's fiscal deficit at 6.3% next year against the government's recent forecast of 6% made in Budget 2022. The rating agency also expects the government's debt limit to be raised to 70% by July 2023 from the current level of 65%.

#### **Economy**

The US jobs report for October came in well above expectations as Non-Farm Payrolls registered a reading of 531,000 against the market forecast of 425,000 jobs. The US unemployment rate too was better than expected at 4.6% against a forecast of 4.7% and the preceding month's print of 4.8%. Other economic data points saw US Producer Price Index (PPI) rising by 8.6% y-o-y in October.

Out of China, October trade data beat the consensus estimate as both exports and imports rose by 27.1% and 20.6% respectively. This resulted in the monthly trade surplus surging to US\$84.5bil against the preceding month's surplus of US\$66.8bil. Chinese inflation data too were released this week and both the PPI and CPI for October came in well above expectations at 13.5% and 1.5% increase respectively from a year earlier. The PPI print was highest in 26 years while headline CPI was strongest since September 2020. Meanwhile, China's automotive sector remains challenging as October sales dipped 9.4% y-o-y to 2.33mil vehicles.

Neighbours Indonesia reported their 3Q GDP data which showed the economy slowed down more than expected with a growth rate of 3.5% y-o-y against the market forecast of a 3.9% expansion. The 3Q 2021 GDP growth was almost half of the preceding quarter's momentum of 7.1% y-o-y. It was a different story for the Philippines though, as its 3Q report card showed the economy expanded at a much faster pace than expected, as GDP grew by 7.1% y-o-y against the consensus estimate of a 4.5% expansion. Up north, the Bank of Thailand maintained the key benchmark rate at 0.5%, as expected.

Locally, according to the Malaysia Institute of Economic Research (MIER), both the Consumer Sentiment Index and the Business Condition Index for the 3Q of 2021 surged to 101.7 and

97.0 from the preceding quarter's reading of 64.3 and 87.5 respectively. The positive momentum is a reflection of the opening up of the economy almost fully since early October as well as the positive rate of inoculation of the Covid-19 vaccine. Meanwhile, Malaysia's International Reserves as at October 29, 2021, rose by US\$0.5bil to US\$116.1bil from US\$115.6bil reported a fortnight ago. In Ringgit terms, Malaysia's international reserves hit a fresh record high of RM486.22bil. Data also showed that Malaysia had a net foreign inflow of RM2.9bil and RM1.6bil into the fixed income and equity market for October respectively. This brought total net inflow into the fixed income market to RM31.0bil but for the equity market, foreigners remain net sellers with a total outflow of RM2.2bil year-to-date.

Other economic data points released by the Department of Statistics showed Malaysia's labour market continues to improve as the unemployment rate fell to 4.5% for September. The number of unemployed persons dropped 2.6% m-o-m to 729,600 from 748,800 in the preceding month, while the number of employed persons improved 0.6% m-o-m to 15.46mil from 15.38mil in August.

Meanwhile, Malaysia's September Industrial Production Index (IPI) improved 2.5% y-o-y, as the manufacturing index and electricity index expanded by 4% and 0.4% y-o-y respectively. However, the mining index was weaker as it fell by 3% y-o-y. Malaysia's manufacturing sales for September grew by 11.6% to hit RM135.3bil with growth mainly from the Petroleum Chemical, Rubber & Plastics industry, which expanded by 29.2% y-o-y, and the Food, Beverage & Tobacco industry, which grew by 12.0% y-o-y. Electrical and Electronics Products sector too was commendable, rising by 10.8% y-o-y.

Malaysia's palm oil statistics showed October production improved by just 1.3% to 1.73 million metric tonnes (MT) but stockpile rose 4.4% m-o-m to reach 1.83mil MT as exports, fell by 12% m-o-m to 1.42mil MT. Year-to-date, palm oil production is down by 7.9% to 15.0mil MT against 16.3mil MT a year earlier.

#### Corporate

Kapar Energy Ventures Sdn. Bhd. (KEV), which is 60% owned by Tenaga Nasional and 40% by Malakoff Corporation, has been served notices of assessment from the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) amounting to RM596m. According to KEV, it has a good basis in law to challenge the assessments as they were incorrectly raised by the IRB.

In other news, Parkson Holdings is taking steps to clean up its balance sheet with a proposal to reduce its share capital to the tune of RM2bil, which will help the company to turn the group's accumulated losses of RM973.7mil into retained earnings of RM1,026.1mil. The total number of shares issued will remain unchanged at 1,093.9mil shares. Meanwhile, Scientex has failed to take Daibochi private as it did not secure the required 90% shareholding in the latter at the close of the offer period.

In an announcement made by the New York State Gaming Commission, a total of 8 platform providers and 9 operators have been chosen for the New York Mobile Sports Wagering. Empire Resorts Inc., a company that is 49% owned by Genting Malaysia, together with Pointsbet, has been chosen as one of the nine operators, under the Pointsbet platform.

Meanwhile, Air Asia Group's (AAG) shareholders have approved the company's proposed rights issue, which would help the company to raise as much as RM1.02bil via the issuance of two Redeemable Convertible Unsecured Islamic Debt Securities (RCUIDS) with one free warrant for every six AAG shares held at RM0.75 per RCUIDS each. The RCUIDS carries a coupon of 8% per year and is convertible into ordinary AAG shares on the basis of one-forone.

#### **Equity**

World equity markets closed mostly mixed the past week on rising inflationary fears but comforted by selected robust economic data points. Markets that rose gained between 0.1% and 2.2% while markets that fell dropped between 0.2% and 2%. The Jakarta Stock Exchange emerged as one of the biggest winners this week as the Composite Index hit a new all-time high. Locally, the main stock index remained under pressure as investors are still adjusting to Budget 2022 tax measures, in particular those related to Prosperity Tax and the imposition of higher stamp duty for stock transactions. At the close of Thursday's trading session, the KLCI gave up 12.48 pts or 0.8% lower week-on-week at 1,518.85 pts.

For the holiday-shortened week ended Nov 10th, foreigners returned as the largest net buyers with an inflow of RM185.2mil, followed by a net inflow of RM170mil among retail investors. This left the local institutions as the largest net sellers with an outflow amounting to RM355.2mil.

#### **Eye on Week Ahead**


Later today, the preliminary University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment for November will be released, which is expected to show a slight pick-up in sentiment to 72.4 from the preceding month's print of 71.7. On Monday, November 15, Japan will report its 3Q GDP performance with economists expecting a contraction of 0.8% annualized rate. On the same day, China will be releasing the October data points for retail sales and industrial production, which is expected to grow by 3.0% and 3.5% y-o-y respectively, as well as the year-to-date fixed asset investment data. Out of the US, the October US Retail Sales, Housing Starts, and Building Permit data will be released on Wednesday, November 17.

Later today, all eyes will be on the release of Malaysia's 3Q GDP data as the market is looking for the economy to contract 2.1% y-o-y. Investors will also be on the lookout for AirAsia X's Court Convene Meeting to approve the company's proposed debt restructuring scheme.

# How Bursa Malaysia's diverse stakeholders are impacted by Budget 2022

Budgeting can perhaps be likened to a game of chess – a game where careful planning, strategic thinking and risk taking conjure in the quest to distribute scarce financial resources around without being able to satisfy/please every stratum of the society. Such is the gist of the RM332.1 billion expansionary Budget 2022 – the nation's largest to-date - which boasts a prorecovery fiscal dynamic approach. Maybank IB Research has pointed out that the Budget also has a negatively-biased equity market impact no thanks to the broad 2022 earnings drag as a result of the one-off Cukai Makmur (CM) a.k.a prosperity tax. "Reflecting windfall tax earnings growth overhang - and caution regarding potential for further levies given the tenuous fiscal position - we cut end-2021 FBM KLCI target to 1,530 from 1,720 previously," projected the research house in its Budget 2022 review dated 31 October 2021. This one-time additional corporate tax of 33% is applied on companies reporting taxable income in excess of RM100 million (24% for the first RM100 million).

RHB Research estimated a worst-case impact of up to 12% on corporate earnings although this should be offset by the positive spill-over to the broader economy from the expansionary budget proposals. "Such a windfall tax is unprecedented in scope and scale – and should be categorised by investors as a policy risk as well as a negative from the perspective of attracting new foreign direct investments and regional competitiveness, reflecting the country's narrow revenue bandwidth and limited fiscal headroom," deduced head of research Alexander Chia.

In the view of Affin Hwang Asset Management senior director of equites Gan Eng Peng, it's all about being penny wise but pound foolish in the Government's quest to raise a projected windfall tax of up to RM4.9 billion. "We believe the wealth destruction via the capital markets could be greater than the potential income raised. This 37% spike in tax rate effectively wipes out most of the already modest 5% -10% earnings growth of 2022," he argued. "Markets are priced-off future growth, the lack of which leads to potential derating as well as immediate kneejerk sell-down to account for this impact. We think the broader market might correct 1%-3% in the near-term, potentially wiping off RM20-50 billion in value."

Like Maybank IB Research, Kenanga Research also adjusted downward its FBM KLCI target for 2021 in view of adverse impact from the imposition of Cukai Makmur. "As the taxable income in excess of RM100 million will be subjected to an additional 9% tax rate (given the current statutory tax rate of 24%), the EPS (earnings per share) of the FBM KLCI could be reduced by 9% from RM1.08 to 98.1 sen by our estimates," justified head of Research Koh Huat Soon. "We project that based only on the 30 KLCI component stocks, the Government stands to gain an incremental RM5.8 billion additional tax income from this measure. Our earlier target for the KLCI of 1,611 is hence reduced to 1,601 or by less than 1% given that this only results in a oneoff impact."

#### Stamp duty hike

In addition to the prosperity tax, Budget 2022 has also proposed to raise the stamp duty rate on contract notes to 0.15% from the current 0.1% with the ceiling and service tax removed. Commenting on the matter, CGS-CIMB Research was negatively surprised by the move to raise the stamp duty rate of contract notes for the trading of shares on Bursa Malaysia to 0.15% (equivalent to RM1.50 for every RM1,000) from 0.1% as well as the decision to abolish the stamp duty limit of RM200 (introduced in 2003) for each related contract note effective 1 January 2022. This, CGS-CIMB said, is partially offset by the exemption from the 6% service tax on brokerage services related to the trading of shares.

"We are negative on this as it will raise the transaction cost for the trading of shares. We estimate this could raise total transaction cost from 0.18% to 0.32% of value of trade of RM5 mil assuming a brokerage rate of 0.15%," projected the research house. "This is because the increase in stamp duty cost to RM7,500 from a max value of RM200 more than offsets the savings from the service tax of RM400. The higher transaction cost could push high-volume stock market traders to venture into other stock exchanges with lower transaction cost and dampen trading activities in the local market. This is likely to be negative for stockbrokers in Malaysia and Bursa."

#### Palm oil windfall levy thresholds

Elsewhere, Budget 2022 has also proposed adjustments to the threshold for imposing palm oil windfall profit levy from RM2,500/tonne to RM3,000/ for Peninsula and from RM3,000/ tonne to RM3,500/tonne for Sabah and Sarawak. The levies for both Peninsular and East Malaysia which were 3.0% and 1.5% respectively are now equalised to 3.0% for both. Essentially, this revision works to the benefit of planters in Peninsular Malaysia and are negative to East Malaysia planters at the current crude palm oil (CPO) price.

#### **ESG** agenda

On a more positive note, Budget 2022 deserves praises for incorporating the inclusivity and sustainability themes which are aligned with the global momentum of environment, social and governance (ESG) and the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). With the global push towards ESG compliance, Budget 2022 has reinforced the need for Malaysian companies and the local supply chain to adopt ESG frameworks premised on higher value creation. This would also resonate with international investors who increasingly demand more robust ESG strategies, potentially attracting highervalue investments. Inevitably, investors and stakeholders are scrutinising various supply chain sustainability aspects of businesses - from carbon emissions to diversity and inclusion, be it gender, race, age or ability.

While larger businesses lead in ESG practices, relatively smaller businesses are beginning to pivot as they endeavour to meet growing customer demands in those aspects. "Sustainability is no longer just a highly topical issue for activist investors and nongovernmental organisations," commented ICAEW (Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales) Malaysia head Loh Wei Yuen. "It is in the spotlight for policymakers, regulators and businesses who are integrating these measures into their core strategies. Now is the time to make the decisive step towards global standard-setting for the benefit of all." While more Malaysian companies have already begun to embrace sustainability, it cannot be denied that more must be done to integrate ESG practices into decision-making processes to ensure that organisations thrive financially while creating value for the Malaysian society, environment and economy.

#### At least one female director in PLCs - a move in the right direction

In the same light, Budget 2022 promotes gender diversity vis-à-vis the empowerment of women's participation in the economy. The time has come to strengthen female directorship composition in public listed companies (PLCs) by ensuring at least one female director is appointed in all PLCs.

Such mandatory appointment of female board representation in PLCs not only improves corporate governance but signals a shift towards a more inclusive and diverse Malaysian corporate culture. This is also in line with the practice of having a board that comprises 30% women directors under the Malaysian Code on Corporate Governance (MCCG). As MCCG is a Code premised on the 'apply or explain an alternative' approach, there is no mandatory requirement to have a woman director on the board of PLCs. Currently, 252 Malaysian PLCs have no woman directors on their Board - with 4 of the PLCs being in the top-100 category. When persuasion and influence through advocated practices in a principle-based Code do not have the desired outcome, there is a need for mandatory requirements. After all, about half of the Malaysian population comprise women. Surely, having at least one woman on a board is not such an insurmountable task. It is preferable if at least one of the women directors occupies the position of independent non-executive directors so that they may bring an independent women-perspective to board deliberations. MSWG is convinced that there are adequate women of calibre to satisfy the demand for independent women directors. Where there is a will, there is a way. As a prerequisite, there must be a 'will'.

#### Conclusion

The Budget has taken a utilitarian approach to do the greatest good for greatest number of people. Some will feel short-changed. Many will have an alternate approach as to how the Budget should be formulated. It is perhaps a case of the end justifying the means.
