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
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
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Listing momentum seen continuing into 2022 - Investors keen on businesses with tech, digital touch

Deloitte Malaysia IPO leader Wong Kar Choon foresees a continuous momentum of listings next year as economic recovery gets underway in view of the higher number of initial public offerings (IPOs) on Bursa Malaysia this year. There are some potential IPOs next year as the firm received enquiries on IPOs from its clients. He said that based on what they know in the market and how busy they are with clients, he feels very bullish about IPO listings in the coming year. The number of positive Covid-19 cases are declining and coupled with the additional booster vaccination shots, these provide confidence to the capital market. Malaysia saw a higher number of IPO listings this year, totalling 25 year-to-date from 19 listings last year, bolstered by the drive-in vaccination rates and the reopening of the economy. Despite it being the second year of the pandemic, fund raising has not stopped. Companies have continued to attract investments through mergers and acquisitions as well as IPOs. There is still continuous support of retail investors in the market. Of the 25 listings up until now, Malaysia has had four Main Market IPOs, followed by 11 in the ACE Market and the remainder in the LEAP Market. Proceeds raised from the IPOs were lower at RM789mil from RM1.9bil last year mainly due to MR DIY Group (M) Bhd's listing that raised RM1.5bil the year before. The proceeds raised made MR DIY Group's IPO the largest in three years and the only listing to surpass the billion-ringgit threshold last year. In 2021, there was no such big IPO. However, CTOS Digital Bhd (which was listed this year) also did an outright offer of sale of RM990mil plus the RM200mil from the public funds raised, making it an impressive RM1.2bil deal, especially in the pandemic year. There is an increase in the number of real estate sector listings in the country this year compared to a year ago as a result of the economic recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic. Property technology firms would gather an attractive IPO listing in Malaysia, noting that property tech listings in other countries have been appealing to retail and cornerstone investors. The capital market in Malaysia continues to be vibrant, supported by both retail and cornerstone investors. They are interested in particularly certain type of businesses that have technology and digital outreach. They will look out for outfits that disrupt conventional businesses. It is also worth noting that price-to-earnings ratio of tech companies tends to be higher than conventional businesses.

According to Deloitte Malaysia business tax executive director Choy Mei Won, the government's proposal to remove the RM200 stamp duty on contract notes for the trading of listed shares and increasing the rate to


0.15% would make it more expensive to buy and sell shares. It would impact intraday traders, given their high frequency of buying and selling transactions. Following the move, potentially a marginal percentage of intraday traders may be attracted to trade in other financial hubs such as Singapore and Hong Kong.

Lack of impetus could leave market directionless - Inter-Pacific Securities

Inter-Pacific Securities Sdn Bhd said there is still a lack of market impetus, and this could leave the market directionless over the near term. The research house said that once again, the key index made little headway as fresh buying interest remains thin, despite the prospects of an early General Election following the Melaka state election. As it is, there were still few leads to draw market players and as a result, traded volumes continue to fall and slipping to just 2.45b shares - its lowest in 2021. The broader market was also directionless and became broadly lower to result in losers still overwhelming gainers for the day. Fresh buying interest remains anaemic with the ongoing results reporting not providing the much-needed catalysts to attract more market players back to the market. Therefore, the wait-and-see stance is likely to prolong and keep the FBM KLCI trapped within a tight range for the time being, hovering between the 1,520 and 1,530 levels over the near term. The other support and resistance levels are at 1,515 and 1,540 points respectively. The lower liners and broader market shares are also experiencing low participation, and this is likely to prolong their insipid outlook. With few positive leads, the selling and profit taking activities could also stay and leave most of these stocks lower for the time being.

Eye On The Markets

This week, on Friday (26Nov), the Ringgit opened at 4.2345 against the USD from 4.1890 on Monday (22Nov). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0939 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (26Nov). On Monday (22Nov), the FBM KLCI opened at 1526.76. As at Friday (26Nov) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 13.12 points for the week at 1513.64. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 9.42 points (-0.03%) to 35,804.38 whilst the NASDAQ added 70.10 points (+0.44%) to 15,845.20.

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

Powell Maintains Power

Markets

President Joe Biden has re-appointed Jerome Powell for a second 4-year term as the Federal Reserve chair. Powell has been instrumental in helping the US economy to recover rather quickly from the pandemic as well as bold measures that were put in place to support the real economy as well as financial markets. Meanwhile, minutes of the Fed's last meeting showed some Fed officials are more inclined towards a faster pace of tapering than currently planned if inflation continued to rise. With the labour market seeing vast improvement as seen from the significant decline in weekly jobless claims, which fell to a 52-year low this week, the Fed may be hard-pressed to act much faster than anticipated.

Meanwhile, Washington's effort, in coordination with other countries to bring down the sustained high oil prices seems to have not met the desired results as crude oil remained stubbornly high at more than US\$80/barrel. The US had announced a plan to release 50 million barrels of oil from the U.S. Strategic Petroleum Reserve, or SPR, together with other nations like China, India, Japan, South Korea, and the United Kingdom that may add another 20-30mil barrel in total. As the pace of release of these reserves is expected to be carried out over a period of time, the impact was seen to be mooted.

Economy

Out of the US, the 3Q GDP growth data was raised to 2.1% from the previously reported 2% expansion, but a tad below the market estimate of a 2.2% rise. From the US housing market, the October Existing Home Sales rose by 1% m-o-m to an annualized rate of 6.34mil and ahead of consensus estimates of a 6.2mil print, while the October New Home Sales was marginally firmer at 745,000 annualized pace but much lower than the market forecast of an annualized rate of 800,000.

Other economic news saw the US October Durable Goods Order fall by 0.5% m-o-m, while the headline and the core Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) rose to 5% and 4.1% y-o-y respectively – both at fresh three-decade highs. Meanwhile, other data saw the University of Michigan Final November Consumer Sentiment print at 67.4 from 66.8 initially reported but still below the preceding month's print of 71.7.

Out of the Eurozone, the IHS Markit Flash November Eurozone Composite Purchasing Managers' Index and the Manufacturing PMI showed some recovery in activities as the reading improved to 55.8 and 58.6 from 54.2 and 58.3 in the preceding month respectively.

Across the causeway, Singapore's October core inflation increased to 1.5% against the preceding month's print of 1.2% while headline inflation surged by 3.2%, the highest in eight years, as compared with 2.5% in September.

Meanwhile, Singapore had also bumped up its earlier 3Q GDP data from 6.5% y-o-y growth to 7.1%, while growth for 2022 is now estimated at between 3% and 5%. This week also saw two central banks raising interest rates as both the Reserve Bank of New Zealand and Bank of Korea raised their benchmark interest rate by another 25bps to 0.75% and 1.00% respectively.

Locally, Malaysia's International Reserves position as at November 15 rose US\$0.4bil or 0.3% to US\$116.5bil. In Ringgit terms, Malaysia's reserves hit yet another fresh record high of RM487.7bil. Meanwhile, according to data from National Property Information Centre, the overhang in the residential property segment dropped by 2.6% in the total number of units and 1.7% in total value q-o-q to 31,112 units and RM20.1bil respectively when compared with the preceding quarter.

Corporate

Sunway, together with its joint-venture partner in Singapore, Hoi Hup Realty, has entered into collective Sales & Purchase Agreement to acquire 22 plots of freehold residential land located in Tanjong Katong for S\$815mil or RM2.5bil. Sunway has a 30% stake in the joint-venture company. Meanwhile, healthcare provider, IHH Healthcare is said to be considering a sale of its China business operations in a deal that could be worth as much as US\$1bil or RM4.2bil.

In contract news, Pestech International has secured a RM156.9mil contract from the National Grid Corp of the Philippines (NGCP) to upgrade the South Luzon substations, while Pesona Metro Holdings accepted a RM297.6mil contract from Panasonic Homes MKH Malaysia in relation to the building works and external works for four blocks of service apartments located in Kajang. On the other end of the spectrum, ATA IMS announced it had received notices of termination of contracts from Dyson Operations and Dyson Manufacturing which shall take effect on June 1, 2022.

In quarterly results announcement, Air Asia Group reported a net loss of RM1.11bil for the 3Q period and thus bringing its cumulative nine months loss to RM2.81bil. The low-cost carrier saw revenue of just RM295.9mil as the company's business operations remained interrupted by travel restrictions imposed in Malaysia. Another notable quarterly performance was from Petronas Chemical as the company's 3Q net profit surged 317% y-o-y to RM1.96bil. This brought the company's cumulative nine months earnings to RM5.28bil, more than a four-fold increase compared to a year ago. Blowout performance was also observed among plantation companies as Kuala Lumpur Kepong's 4Q net earnings leapfrogged three-fold to RM625.8mil as revenue surged 48.2% y-o-y. Full-year net earnings of the plantation company too skyrocketed by 192%

to hit RM2.26bil. Maybank too reported their quarterly results which saw Malaysia's largest capitalized company reporting a net profit of RM1.68bil for the 3Q period and thus bringing the cumulative year-to-date net earnings to RM6.04bil. Meanwhile, Tenaga Nasional's 3Q results saw net earnings relatively flat at RM1bil, bringing the cumulative nine-month performance to RM2.78bil, up 16.9% y-o-y, as revenue jumped 9.6% to RM36.9bil.

Equity

World equity markets closed mostly mixed to lower this week. Markets that closed on a weaker note fell by between 0.2% and 2.8% while markets that closed firmer were higher by between 0.3% and 1.8%. Locally, the benchmark index closed lower on selected selling pressure on index-linked stocks. At the close of Thursday's trading session, the KLCI gave up 6.19 pts or 0.4% to close at 1,517.60 pts.

For the week ended November 24, retailers turned sole net buyers in the market with an inflow of RM170mil as both the foreign and local institutions were net sellers with outflows of RM21.4mil and RM148.6mil respectively.


Eye on Week Ahead

On Monday, November 29, the US Pending Home Sales data for October is due while the Chinese official Manufacturing and Non-Manufacturing PMI are due the following day. Also on Tuesday, the Eurozone headline and core inflation data will be closely watched by the market, which market is expecting a reading of 3.7% and 1.9% respectively. The Conference Board's US Consumer Confidence data for November is also due on the last day of November.

On Wednesday, December 1, multiple November IHS Markit Manufacturing PMI indicators are due to be released and this includes those for ASEAN, Malaysia as well the Eurozone, and the JP Morgan Global Manufacturing PMI, while out of the US, the Fed's Beige Book is due to be released. This will be followed by the Institute of Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing PMI for November, which the market is looking at a reading of 61.0 against 60.8 in the preceding month.

Locally, later today the Department of Statistics (DOSM) will be releasing the inflation data for October, while on Monday, November 29, the details of Malaysia's external trade will be released. On Tuesday, November 30, Bank Negara will be releasing the detailed disclosure of its international reserves as at end of October and the banking statistics data, while the DOSM will also be releasing the October Producer Price Index (PPI) on the same day. Next week will also see the last batch of quarterly results from companies with the September 30 quarterly period close.

Inix's unusual blunder over submission of annual report

The intriguing episode of miscommunication between Inix Technologies Holdings Berhad and its auditor which led to a wrong assumption of whether a sign-off is compulsory or otherwise should serve as a valuable lesson to all public listed companies (PLCs). To recap, Inix had released its annual report for the financial year ended 30 June 2021 (FY2021) on 8 November 2021, but only to announce the retraction of annual report on 11 November because its auditor SBY Partners PLT had not signed-off the Audited Financial Statements (AFS) for FY2021. As such, investors are advised not to refer to the said AR2021 which was uploaded on 8 November 2021. Inix said it targeted to upload the final signed version of AR2021 by 12 November. However, a day later, Inix announced that it was still unable to upload the final signed version of AR2021 on the stated day as the auditors had yet to sign-off the AFS for FY2021. Thus, it had missed the targeted deadline to upload the AR2021.

Pursuant to a query by Bursa Malaysia, on 15 November, Inix explained that the delay in signing-off the AFS was due to further queries from auditors arising from their Engagement Quality Control Review, the details of which were not divulged to Inix's management earlier. As to why the Company went ahead to upload/release its Annual Report 2021 on 8 November without the signing-off of its auditors, Inix explained that it was under the impression that it could submit its latest annual report to Bursa Malaysia after the audit partner of SBY Partners PLT informed Inix that it can proceed to print and issue the accounts. The Company nevertheless said a final copy of the AR2021 would be uploaded on 15 November. For the record, trading of INIX's shares has been suspended from 15 November following its failure to meet its targeted deadline of 12 November to publish the signed-off annual

report. The trading suspension was uplifted on 17 November following its submission of AR2021 on 16 November. This blunder has created confusion among shareholders and affected investors' confidence on the board and management of the Company. Minority shareholders may have made investment decisions based on the unsigned AFS thinking that they were signed AFS.

UMA slapped on MGRC as its share price slumps

Often Bursa Malaysia issues an unusual market query (UMA) if the share price of a listed issuer has shot through the roof or when its volume has risen exponentially. But the market regulator can also do the exact opposite as with ACE Market-listed Malaysian Genomics Resource Centre Bhd (MGRC) recently. The operator of one of the largest bio-computational centres for genomics in the region was issued an UMA query on 8 November as its share price plunged 56 sen or 28% to an intra-day low of RM1.44 prior to paring some losses to close at RM1.64. Its share price was still down 36 sen or 18% with 18.3 million shares exchanging hands at the close of trading. In its response to the UMA query, MGRC said it was unaware of any corporate development or rumours/report concerning the business and affairs of the group that may have impacted its share price movement, except the appointment of two new independent non-executive directors namely Wong Yew Sen and Dr. Khoo Boo Boon, as well as an announcement of share acquisition by a substantial shareholder.

Re-emergence of substantial shareholder

Before MGRC was slapped with the UMA query from Bursa Securities, the market saw the re-emergence of Pixelvest Sdn Bhd

as a substantial shareholder of MGRC on 3 November with its stake in MGRC increasing to 5.378% after the acquisition of 550,000 shares in the open market. Earlier, Pixelvest had itself ceased to be a substantial shareholder of MGRC on 10 September following disposal of 1.5 million shares in the open market on 9 September. The re-emergence of Pixelvest also followed the ceasing of I Concept Global Growth Fund as a substantial shareholder of MGRC after the latter's disposal of 4.69 million shares in MGRC between 1 November and 2 November via the open market. Following this, Pixelvest continued to accumulate shares in MGRC with total interest of 6.55% as of 18 November. In a stock exchange filing dated 1 November, MGRC said it remains an affected listed corporation under Rule 8.03A of the ACE Market Listing Requirements following its disposal of MPath Group in December 2019 for RM42 million. "The company has approximately two months until 23 December 2021 to submit a regularisation plan to the relevant authorities for approval and will make further announcements in relation to any latest development," MGRC pointed out. Financial-wise, MGRC fell into the red in its financial year ended 30 June 2021, with a net loss of RM4.29 million (FY2020: net profit of RM17.1 million) mainly because the recognition of profit from discontinued operations amounted to RM23.34 million in the previous financial year. Revenue meanwhile came in at RM1.78 million – up from RM951,000 in the previous corresponding period – mainly on the de-recognition of the progress of genome sequencing and analysis services. Year-to-date, MGRC's share price has edged up 167% from RM1.02 on 4 January to an all-time high of RM2.72 on 29 October prior to the 8 November's downside.


