MALAYSIA TO RECORD 6.0PC ECONOMIC GROWTH IN 2022

ccording to Moody's Investors Service assistant vice-president/ analyst Nishad Majmudar, Malaysia's economy is likely to grow 6.0 per cent this year, driven by the reopening of international borders, high vaccination rates, and as the country enters the transition to the endemic phase. The reopening of international borders would bolster the tourism-related services sector. As for the transition into the endemic phase, over time, he expects that it would support greater economic activity and private consumption in the country. Another factor is the expected weaker growth in key export markets like the European Union, which accounts for about 10 per cent of exports. Nevertheless, Malaysia is exporting quite a diverse basket of goods whereby demand remains in the strong part of the cycle, such as electronics and oil and gas sector, which should perform well with the high prices. He was speaking at Moody's virtual media roundtable titled "Inside Asean: Malaysia". However, there were several downside risks, including the Ukraine-Russia conflict, as well as the potential of a surge in inflation to prompt Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) to react more quickly in terms of policy rate normalisation. The Ukraine-Russia conflict is the biggest downside risk for growth. Moody's has already marked down the forecast for a number of G20 economies, mostly in Europe but also in Asia Pacific and that BNM is expected to raise its policy rate in the second half of 2022. Another round of border closures due to a new variant threat would be another potential risk but the Malaysian government had indicated its interest to keep the economy open and treat Covid-19 as an endemic. Additionally, a volatile political environment would undermine Malaysia's credibility

and effectiveness of institutions, as well as threaten the stability of capital flows and investment, which could be another potential downside risk for Malaysia. In his assessment over the last few years, some of the political noises have not affected the functioning of key economic institutions such as the Finance Ministry, Bank Negara, and securities regulators. However, the uncertainties around the election timing and the relatively thin majority in Parliament, have constrained the fiscal reform process most notably and made it difficult for any of the governments over the last three years, to focus on some of these reforms. If the general elections were to come soon, it could potentially lead to a more volatile political environment and political noises, but would not affect the functioning of the key institutions overall. Meanwhile, Brent crude price is expected to remain above US\$100 per barrel this year. According to Moody's analyst Hui Ting Sim, the rating agency expects Petroliam Nasional Bhd (Petronas) to spend more of its capital spending this year, which could benefit the exploration and production contractors and oilfield services companies. In terms of top-line, they are quite positive as there will be more business for the players in the oilfield service industry. The outlook for earnings and cashflows potentially could be less positive because these companies will incur higher operating costs this year because of the inflationary pressure that leads to higher utility, equipment, and labour costs. Profitability of these companies will depend on their ability to pass through the increase in costs to oil and gas producers.

MIDF RESEARCH: FOREIGN INVESTORS REMAIN NET **BUYERS LAST WEEK WITH INFLOW OF RM536.5M**

According to MIDF Research, foreign investors were the only net buyers for the week ended April 1, with the net inflows amounting to RM536.5 million. In its equity strategy report, the investment bank said international funds have been net buyers on Bursa Malaysia for 11 out of the first 13 weeks of 2022, with a net inflow of RM6.66 billion yearto-date. Foreign investors were net buyers in all the trading days last week, with the largest amount recorded on Friday at RM194.8 million



and the smallest on Tuesday at RM30.7 million. Financial services, plantation and industrial products and services continue to be the most favoured sectors by foreign investors last week, with net inflows of RM335.6 million, RM100.4 million and RM54.6 million, respectively. As for local retailers, the research house said the local retailer movements were rather mixed last week with three days of net selling and two days of net buying, culminating with a net selling position at -RM72.74 million for the week. They were net sellers on Wednesday (RM36.12 million), Thursday (RM30.56 million) and Friday (RM80.96 million), and were net buyers on Monday (RM17.39 million) and Tuesday (RM57.51 million). Local institutions remained as net sellers with the largest selling recorded on Monday at -RM138.2 million and the smallest amount on Wednesday at -RM51.4 million. Local institutions' net buys were in the healthcare and construction sectors at RM62.8 million and RM4.0 million, respectively. Overall, local institutions were net sellers at -RM463.75 million. On a year-to-date basis, local institutions are net sellers to the tune of RM7.08 billion, while local retailers and foreign investors have been net buyers at RM0.42 billion and RM6.7 billion, respectively. In terms of participation, only foreign investors recorded an increase in average daily trade value at 5.95 per cent, while local institutions and local retailers recorded declines of 20.47 per cent and 13.49 per cent, respectively.

GOVT REMAINS COUNTRY'S TOP BOND ISSUER


According to Bond Pricing Agency Malaysia Sdn Bhd's (BPAM), the Malaysian government has been named the overall top bond issuer for the first quarter (1Q) of 2022, with a total issuance of RM50bil. The government also issued the top traded bond overall for the quarter under review at RM205.06bil. The government had also been the top bond issuer overall and issued the top traded bond in the fourth quarter of last year. National mortgage corporation Cagamas Bhd was the top corporate bond issuer (RM1.88bil) for 1Q this year and also issued the top traded corporate bond (RM590mil). Maybank Islamic Bank Bhd was the top sukuk issuer (RM4bil) in the quarter, while DanaInfra Nasional Bhd issued the top traded sukuk (RM2.8bil). Malaysian Trustees Bhd



emerged as the top bond trustee overall both by value (RM9.48bil) and issuance (101 issues) for the quarter under review. It was also the top sukuk trustee by value (RM7.68bil). PB Trustees Services Bhd was the top conventional bond trustee by value (RM2.4bil). These quarterly reports highlight the Malaysian bond market performance and rankings of key bond market players in the given period. BPAM is the only registered bond pricing agency accredited by the Securities Commission.

EYE ON THE MARKETS

This week, on Friday (8Apr), the Ringgit opened at 4.2205 against the USD from 4.2140 on Monday (4Apr). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0982 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (8Apr). On Monday (4Apr), the FBM KLCI opened at 1602.03. As at Friday (1Apr) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 0.97 points for the week at 1601.06. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 87.06 points (+0.25%) to 34,583.57 whilst the NASDAQ added 8.48 points (+0.06%) to 13,897.30.

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ECONOMIC MOMENTUM IS LOSING TRACTION

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s inflation pressure is rising globally, economic momentum seems to have eased with some economies experiencing a contraction in the key Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI). With economic data pointing towards a weaker growth ahead, comments by Federal Reserve Governor that the Fed will be aggressive in reducing the size of its balance sheet as soon as next month shook markets. Fed minutes showed that the Fed is eyeing a Quantitative Tightening (QT) move that will reduce the size of the Fed's balance sheet by as much as US\$95bil a month or US\$1.14 trillion a year.

US treasuries continued their ascent, with the 2yr, 5yr, and 10yr rising by 9bps, 17bps, and 23bps respectively, while equity markets, which have seen some good momentum over the past couple of weeks, saw some profit-taking activities. Meanwhile, Shanghai's move to go for an extended lockdown period following a surge in the number of Covid-19 cases too added to investors' woes on China's economic growth momentum for the 2Q period.

With the US, EU, and members of G7 dishing out a fresh round of sanctions on Russia, including a US ban on investment in Russia, the EU's move to stop coal imports as well as sanctions on

key individuals, markets went into another round of uncertainty as commodity prices were back in the groove with oil hitting US\$107 per barrel before easing to just above the US\$101 mark.

For Malaysia, the World Bank lowered its GDP growth estimate for 2022 by 30bps to 5.5% to take into account the impact of the Russia-Ukraine war. However, the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Moody's Investors' Service, raised their respective forecast GDP growth for Malaysia to 6% from 5.9% and 4.8% previously estimated. ADB has also called upon Asian central banks to tighten monetary policy despite the region's manageable inflation prints.

ECONOMY

Global economic momentum has eased as both the J.P. Morgan Global Manufacturing PMI and the J.P. Morgan Global Composite Output Index for March dropped to 53.0 and 52.7 from 53.7 and 53.5 in the preceding month. The trend was also echoed in the Final S&P Global Eurozone Manufacturing PMI and the Final S&P Global Eurozone Composite PMI for March, which fell to 56.5 and 54.9 from 58.2 and 55.5 in February respectively.

The S&P Global ASEAN PMI and the S&P Global Malaysian PMI too suffered similar faiths as both declined to 51.7 and 49.6 in March from 52.5 and 50.9 respectively in February. Meanwhile, for the US, the Institute of Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing PMI and Services PMI came in at 57.1 and 58.3 from the preceding month's prints of 58.6 and 56.5 respectively. The US ISM Manufacturing PMI slumped to an 18-month low.

In other US economic news, the March jobs report saw Non-Farm Payroll coming in below expectations at 431,000 against the market forecast of 490,000 but the rate of unemployment improved to 3.6% against the 3.7% that was estimated by economists. Average Hourly Earnings rose to 5.6% y-o-y and marginally ahead of expectations of a 5.5% gain.

Up north, Thailand reported a higher than expected headline inflation as the March data saw an increase of 5.7% y-o-y while core inflation rose

by 2% y-o-y. Inflation is also surging in Indonesia as the March inflation jumped 4% y-o-y fuelled by an increase in transport and electricity costs. Down Under, the Reserve Bank of Australia left its key cash target rate unchanged at 0.1%. Locally, Bank Negara Malaysia's (BNM) international reserves position as at end of March 2022 improved by US\$0.4bil compared with a fortnight ago to US\$115.6bil or at RM485.83bil.

CORPORATE

A special purpose vehicle, Amanat Lebuhraya Rakyat (ALR) has made an offer to acquire four urban highways for RM5.48bil enterprise value. The equity value for the four highways was estimated at RM4.43bil while the debt portion is at RM1.05bil. Gamuda's share of the equity value is estimated at RM2.33bil and the company will recognize a net gain of RM1bil, while for Litrak, the equity value for its toll highways is estimated at RM2.7bil, translating to an implied equity value of RM5.06 per share as it will recognize a gain of approximately RM1.38bil from the disposal.

It has been a while since Malaysia last had a banking merger but with the blessing from the central bank, Malaysian Building Society Bhd (MBSB) will commence negotiation with Permodalan Nasional Bhd (PNB) to acquire the asset manager's 100% equity interest held in Malaysian Industrial Development Finance Bhd (MIDF).

In other corporate news, TSH Resources has agreed to dispose of some 13,898 hectares of mostly undeveloped oil palm land located in North East of Kalimantan for RM711.7m cash, which will allow TSH to recognize a gain of RM400.3mil or 26 sen per share.

In contract news, Eastern & Oriental awarded Kerjaya Prospek a RM265mil contract for the main building works comprising two blocks of apartments with 1,020 units located at Sri Tanjong Pinang.

EQUITY

Global markets came under selling pressure as investors took monies off the table on concerns of the Fed's guidance with respect to

rate hikes and detailed plan to shrink the size of its balance sheet. Weaker economic data and continuous tension out of Ukraine added to investors' anxiety. Markets that fell saw losses of between 0.1% to as much as 3.9% on the Philippines Stock Exchange PSEi Index, while three markets that experienced positive momentum this week witnessed gains of 0.8% each. Stocks on Bursa Malaysia were mostly firmer on renewed buying interest among plantation stocks as well as the oil and gas sector. The KLCI gained 13.43 pts or 0.8% higher to close at 1,600.79 pts.

For the week ended April 7, foreign market participants emerged as sole net buyers in the market with an inflow of RM537mil. Both the retail and local institutions were net sellers with outflows of RM162mil and RM375mil respectively.

EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, the Department of Statistics (DOSM) will be releasing the February 2022 labour market report, which will likely see an improvement in Malaysia's unemployment rate from 4.2% to 4.1%.

On Monday, April 11, the focus will shift to China as the key March inflation data will be out. Economists are looking at China's key headline CPI to increase by just 0.1% y-o-y but the Producer Price Index (PPI) is forecasted to jump by 10.4% y-o-y from 8.8% in February. The following day, the US will be releasing its March headline and core inflation prints with the market expecting to rise to 8.3% and 6.6% y-o-y respectively. On Wednesday, April 13, the Reserve Bank of New Zealand meets to decide on its next course of action with respect to its Official Cash Rate, which was last raised by 25bps in its February meeting to 1%. On the same day, China will be releasing the

March external trade data with the market looking at an export and import growth of 20.5% and 17.3% y-o-y, while the UK too will be issuing its March headline inflation, which is estimated to increase by 6.6% y-o-y.

On Thursday, April 14, the focus will shift to the European Central Bank (ECB) as it makes a call on its refinancing rate and rate on its marginal lending facility, which is likely to be left unchanged at 0.0% and 0.25% respectively. Meanwhile, the US Retail Sales for March is also due on the same day, with the market looking at a 0.6% growth from the preceding month.

Locally, on Monday, April 11, the DOSM will be releasing the Monthly Manufacturing Sales data, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) as well as the performance of the Wholesale and Retail Trade for February 2022.

RPTS SWAY SHARE PRICE AND POSE POTENTIAL DETRIMENTAL **EFFECT ON MINORITY** SHAREHOLDERS



n assessment mooted by the Securities Commission (SC) to examine the regulatory regime and practices of relatedparty transactions (RPTs) by PLCs revealed that such corporate exercise poses a significant effect on share price movement on the day after RPT announcements were made. In SC's Annual Report 2021, the regulator observed that there were above-average price movements on the day leading up to the RPT announcements. This suggested that there could be some leakages of price-sensitive information before RPT announcements were made publicly.

For the uninitiated, RPT is a transaction entered into by a PLC which involves the interest of a director, major shareholder or person connected with such director or major shareholder. In addition, the SC's assessment on several large RPTs - ranging from RM250 million to more than RM3 billion - suggested that RPTs involving PLCs within family groups and those with longserving independent directors may require closer monitoring to ensure that the transactions are not detrimental to minority shareholders. There were also instances where RPT issues and concerns were uncovered by auditors of financially distressed PLCs, said SC in its Annual Report 2021. Previous reports by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and CFA Institute highlighted that RPTs were not uncommon in Asia, and while not all RPTs were abusive, occurrences of detrimental RPTs did pose harm to investors.

With that, investors are advised to pay particular attention to general announcements in relation to transaction between related parties who are only connected by common directorships, and memorandum of understanding or heads of agreement between related parties. These transactions or dealings may carry the risk of erosion of minority shareholders protection. Given the prevalence of RPTs among Malaysian PLCs, the boards of PLCs – particularly the independent directors and audit committee – must establish effective processes and controls to prevent detrimental RPTs while ensuring that decisions made on RPTs are in the best interest of the PLCs and its shareholders.

For PLCs, they should ensure that their RPT disclosures and disclosures of other dealings between related parties are timely, complete, and accurate. SC further stresses that PLCs' internal policies on the handling and safeguarding of material non-public information should cover RPTs that are likely to have a material price impact.

Apart from SC's observation on RPTs, we also found out some interesting points from the SC's Annual Report 2021:

REGULATED SHORT SELLING ACTIVITIES

Upon resumption of regulated short selling (RSS) trading on 4 January 2021, the SC observed that renewed risk management activities resulted in fairly active RSS trades before moderating to an average of about 1% of the total market value traded throughout 2021. In addition, developments surrounding the GameStop short squeeze incident by retailers in the US gave rise to concerns over similar risks associated with domestic short-selling activities. However, such risks did not materialise in the domestic market given its different environment and regulatory framework including prescribed limits on short selling positions, among others. Overall, RSS activities were well-governed with enhanced and existing control measures in place to ensure market stability and mitigate against risks of excessive net-short positions. Such controls include tighter aggregate net-short position limits, trading tick rules, and daily short selling volume limits.

MISLEADING DISCLOSURES

In 2021, potential wrongdoing detected by the SC included possible misleading disclosures made by listed companies which may have induced trading activities or influenced the market price of securities.

This was in light of the increase in the number of announcements made by PLCs into COVID-19 or healthcare-related ventures amid the COVID-19 pandemic. The SC had monitored and assessed such disclosures to ensure PLCs do not take advantage of the current pandemic by making any false or misleading statements that may influence investors' investment decisions.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS

Some PLCs were found not to have complied with the approved accounting standards in relation to the accounting treatment of investments in wholesale funds. It was found that certain listed companies managed their cash surplus by investing in wholesale funds and there were instances where the wholesale funds appeared to cater primarily to the listed company's specific cash management requirements. Some of these wholesale funds held investment portfolios that consist mainly or wholly of the financial instruments of the listed company and its related companies. This may result in the listed company having effective control over the wholesale funds. If such control exists, the accounting treatment for the listed company's investments in the wholesale funds should be assessed and reflected accordingly.

The SC also noted an instance of non-compliance with approved accounting standards in relation to the failure to re-classify certain perpetual sukuk (Islamic bond) from equity instruments to financial liability when the listed company no longer has an unconditional right to avoid the redemption of the perpetual sukuk.

ENFORCEMENT (CRIMINAL ACTION)

Throughout 2021, a total of 10 criminal charges were filed against six individuals and one PLC for unlicensed activities and furnishing false information in financial reporting. Additionally, one criminal forfeiture application was filed against an individual and a private limited company in connection to money laundering offences.

Elsewhere, three convictions were secured against three individuals for cases involving insider trading, furnishing misleading information in financial reporting, and failure to appear before an investigating officer of the SC in connection with an investigation under the Anti-Money Laundering, Anti-Terrorism and Proceeds of Unlawful Activities Act 2021 (AMLATFPUAA). All-in-all, RM7.57million in total fine was imposed.

ENFORCEMENT (CIVIL ACTION)

The SC filed six civil actions in 2021, against 10 individuals. Four consent judgments were also recorded between the SC and eight individuals. Total civil penalties imposed amounted to RM2.5 million.

REGULATORY SETTLEMENT WITH AMMB HOLDINGS **BERHAD**

In 2021, SC had completed its investigation on AMMB Holdings Bhd (AmBank Group) in relation to 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB) as well as non-compliance with the SC's relevant laws and guidelines. With that, the SC had entered into an arrangement with AmBank Group to settle all pending regulatory actions relating to or in connection with:

- RM5 billion Government Guaranteed Islamic Medium Term Notes (IMTN) Programme due in 2039 which was issued by the Terengganu Investment Authority (TIA, now known as 1MDB) in May 2009; and
- RM2.4 billion Sukuk Murabahah Programme due between 2021 and 2024 which was issued by Bandar Malaysia Sdn Bhd (BMSB) in February 2014 and December 2014.

The settlement of the TIA IMTN was made on a without admission or denial of liability basis by AmBank Group. AmBank Group also acknowledged the breaches of securities laws identified by the SC on the matter relating to the BMSB Sukuk Murabahah.





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


