

# Is there an investment opportunity in Kirby

## SUMMARY

- **Kirby (KEX.NY)** has transitioned from a diversified conglomerate to a marine transportation and diesel services company, with Marine Transportation contributing more revenue but Distribution & Services delivering higher returns on assets.


- Growth has been driven heavily by acquisitions. Despite this, it only delivered a 3.5% CAGR in revenue over the past 12 years. Profits have stagnated due to declining margins and rising costs, with ROIC and ROE consistently below the cost of capital, indicating no value creation.
- While financially stable with strong cash flows and low debt, it had an unsustainably high Reinvestment rate. Kirby's stock is also fairly valued at USD106 - its estimated intrinsic value - offering no margin of safety for long-term value investors.

## **BACKGROUND**

Kirby was listed on the NYSE in 1976 as a diversified company involved in oil and gas exploration and production, marine transportation, and property and casualty insurance. Over the next few decades, a series of acquisitions and divestitures transformed the company. By 2012, it had evolved into a marine transportation and diesel engine services company.

In 2017, Kirby consolidated its diesel engine services into the newly formed Distribution & Services segment. Today, the company operates through two main business segments:

- **Marine Transportation:** This segment offers marine transportation services via tank barges for inland and coastal markets. This was the largest contributor to total company revenue in 2023, representing 58% of total revenue (see Chart 1, left side).
- **Distribution & Services:** This segment serves two markets - Commercial & Industrial (contributing 59% of segment revenue in 2023) and Oil & Gas.



Despite Marine Transportation accounting for a greater share of total assets, Distribution & Services delivered a higher average return on assets:

- **Marine Transportation:** Return on total assets ranged from 1.5% to 5.4%, averaging 3.7%.
- **Distribution & Services:** Returns ranged from -1.5% to 9.9%, averaging 5.1%.

From 2011 to 2023, Kirby’s overall revenue grew at a CAGR of 3.5%, suggesting it is now a mature company operating in mature sectors. Market forecasts support this view - the US barge transportation market is expected to grow at a robust CAGR of 7% to 8% through 2028 to 2030, while the North American diesel engine market is projected to grow at a more modest CAGR of 2.7% through 2031. This suggests stronger long-term growth potential in Kirby’s Marine Transportation segment compared to its diesel-related Distribution & Services business.

## **OPERATING PERFORMANCE**


While revenue grew over the past 12 years, profits stagnated. As shown in Chart 2, PAT in 2023 was only 5% higher than in 2012, and PBT (excluding unusual items) was 15% lower. Losses in 2020–2021 stemmed from asset write-downs.

The profit decline was driven by falling gross margins and rising SGA expenses, with a sharp drop in gross margin in 2017 likely due to the restructuring of the Distribution & Services segment. Refer to the right part of Chart 2.

This suggests 2018–2023 is a more relevant period for assessing performance. During this period, Kirby’s average ROIC was 3.4% vs a WACC of 8%, and ROE averaged just 0.1% vs. a cost of equity of 8%, indicating no value creation.

Operational efficiency has deteriorated, with declining gross profitability and no improvement in other key efficiency ratios. While some capital efficiency metrics improved, the overall trend underscores the need for a strategic shift to reverse weak profit and return performance.



## GROWTH CHALLENGES

Kirby’s growth has relied heavily on acquisitions, with 31 deals in marine transportation and 17 in diesel engine services since 1986. From 2012 to 2023, the company spent USD2.2 billion on acquisitions and USD2.7 billion on CAPEX, yet revenue only grew at a 3.5% CAGR, indicating modest returns despite significant investment.

The Reinvestment rate (reinvestment/NOPAT) averaged 138% over the past two years, driven largely by acquisitions.

Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisition – Depreciation & Acquisition + increase in Net Working Capital.

Excluding acquisitions, this drops to a more sustainable 39%. Some acquisitions, like barge purchases, were reported under acquisitions instead of CAPEX, but this accounting nuance does not change the overall picture: Kirby’s growth strategy has been capital-intensive and unsustainable.

Moreover, returns on these investments have been weak. Despite spending about USD2.5 billion (net of depreciation), average operating profits in 2022–2023 were only USD266 million, down from USD390 million in earlier years. This raises concerns about the efficiency and payoff of past growth investments.

## FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Kirby financially sound based on the following.

- From 2012 to 2023, it delivered positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated USD4.6 billion cash flow from operations compared to its USD1.5 billion net income. This is a very good cash conversion ratio.
- As of Dec 2024, it had a Debt Capital ratio of 21%. According to the Damodaran Jan 2024 dataset, the ratio for the transportation sector was 25%.
- It had a reasonable capital allocation plan as shown in Table 2. The cash flow from operations was enough to fund

its CAPEX and acquisitions. But there was not much left to return to shareholders.

While Kirby also had some negative points, they are not insurmountable, especially the Reinvestment rate, which is within management control.

- It had USD74 million in cash and short-term investments as of the end of December 2024. This was about 1% of its total assets.
- Over the past 12 years, it had an unsustainable Reinvestment rate of 138%. Excluding the acquisitions, it had an average Reinvestment rate of 39%.

## VALUATION

My analysis suggests that the company achieved growth through acquisitions. Despite topline growth, there were hardly any changes in operating and capital efficiencies. As such I adopted the following picture in valuing the company. Refer to the original article for the details.

The company will continue pursuing acquisitions over the next five years.

- Specifically, I modelled a major acquisition in Year 1 that drives a 20% revenue increase, consistent with the growth achieved between 2021 and 2024.
- Thereafter, both acquisition activity and revenue growth taper off, reaching a terminal growth rate of 4% by Year 6.

The Reinvestment rate starts at historical levels and gradually declines, aligning with the rate excluding acquisitions by the terminal year.

Given the cyclical nature of parts of Kirby's business, I used the average margins from 2018 to 2023 to represent normalized profitability across the cycle. On such a basis, I obtained an intrinsic value of USD106 per share compared to its market price of USD106 per share (end Dec 2024). There is no margin of safety.

## CONCLUSION

Kirby is a financially sound company operating in mature sectors, with a history of acquisition-led growth. However, its long-term profitability and efficiency metrics have stagnated, and its reinvestment strategy appears unsustainable without clearer returns.

While the company has maintained solid operating cash flows and a conservative balance sheet, it has not created meaningful shareholder value in recent years.

My valuation, based on a continuation of its current strategy and normalized margins, suggests that the stock is fairly valued at USD106, offering no margin of safety. As a long-term value investor, I see limited upside under current conditions.

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# ASEAN green initiatives can generate additional US\$300b by 2030 - Zafrul

**A**ccording to Investment, Trade and Industry Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, ASEAN could generate an additional US\$300 billion (RM1.27 trillion) annually in green revenues and unlock up to US\$1.5 trillion in new value by 2030 with advancing green investments and cross-border collaboration in regional power grids, carbon markets, and clean energy incentives.

In his keynote address at the ASEAN Business Forum (ABC) 2025 which was delivered by Malaysian Investment Development Authority (MIDA) chief executive officer Datuk Sikh Shamsul Ibrahim Sikh Abdul Majid, he noted that Malaysia's green investment strategy delivered close to 1,000 approved projects in 2024, channelling RM20.8 billion into the economy and creating thousands of future-ready jobs. He added that ABC is pushing for

key frameworks and regulatory provisions to put green ambition into action. These include the ASEAN Taxonomy for Sustainable Finance, Sustainable Investment Guidelines, and the Greening Value Chain Playbook.

He added that there is also the ASEAN Strategy for Carbon Neutrality, with initiatives such as harmonising carbon markets and measurement standards, advancing carbon capture, utilisation, and storage technologies, and creating a just transition framework for workers and communities. These help to facilitate the corporate sector's pivot towards sustainable, climate-friendly growth.

He pointed out that the most transformative is the ASEAN Power Grid (APG). With 18 cross-border power projects in the pipeline and over 60 renewable energy sites identified, the APG stands as a flagship for ASEAN's sustainable energy transition. The APG could add up to US\$3 trillion in GDP value by 2050 and create 1.45 million jobs regionally.

The APG's success would rely on strategic funding from banks like the Asian Development Bank and the World Bank, ensuring ASEAN centrality and regional autonomy.

Apart from that, Zafrul also mentioned that the ASEAN Digital Economy Framework Agreement, now in advanced negotiations, aims to double ASEAN's digital economy to US\$2 trillion by 2030, connecting e-commerce, financial technology, digital finance, and artificial intelligence-enabled solutions across borders.

In 2024, ASEAN's digital sector saw profits triple to US\$11 billion and attracted over US\$30 billion in new data centre investments. This surge is being fuelled by the youthful population, rapid urbanisation, and robust public-private partnerships. He also cited an example where unlocking the potential of ASEAN's 334 million women, roughly half of ASEAN's population, could add up to US\$2.3 trillion to regional GDP.

# ASEAN private market association set to launch by year end - Nazir Razak

**A**ccording to Tan Sri Nazir Razak, the chair for the ASEAN Business Advisory Council (ASEAN-BAC) Malaysia, a new private market association is expected to be set up by year end to advise ASEAN governments on policies that support the growth of the industry. A pro-tem committee - comprising members from Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, and Indonesia - has already been formed and is working towards the formal establishment of the association by year end.

He was speaking on the sidelines of the ASEAN Business Forum 2025 when he said that among the issues to be discussed are market fragmentation, rules on taxation and ownership for the growth of the private market industry.

The ASEAN-BAC was formed following the 7th ASEAN Summit with the mandate to provide private-sector feedback and guidance to boost efforts towards economic integration. Accordingly, the

ASEAN-BAC's activities are primarily focused on reviewing and identifying issues to facilitate and promote economic cooperation and integration.

He said that the private markets industry is extremely important to the economy but remains too small, contributing only 0.5% to GDP compared to the global benchmark of 1.5%. ASEAN may require up to US\$60 billion (RM254.49 billion) in capital channelled to private equity and venture funds.

He noted that certain reforms are needed in order for this to happen, but the ASEAN-BAC is going ahead with the process of setting up this ASEAN private market association to help drive industry development.

He highlighted some of the association's initiatives, including the proposal for an ASEAN initial public offering (IPO) prospectus – under which companies seeking a public listing in ASEAN markets will have the option to issue either a domestic or an ASEAN-wide prospectus. Another proposal is the ASEAN Business Entity (ABE) status designed to support qualified companies within ASEAN, offering them a range of operational flexibilities. Companies that qualify for ABE status could benefit from the free movement of outsourcing, capital, skilled labour, and higher maximum shareholding limits, providing them with greater control and expansion opportunities. He said the proposals have been recommended to the government and are still work in progress.



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
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
## EYE ON THE MARKETS

**F**inancial institutions must move beyond compliance by phasing out high-risk financing, conducting rigorous due diligence, and maintaining transparency. They must prioritise sustainability over short-term profits, even if it means walking away from risky deals.

## **THE HIDDEN CHAINSAW: WHY FIs SHOULDN'T FUND DEFORESTATION**

Let's talk about something we don't always see but that affects all of us: deforestation. It may seem distant, perhaps something happening deep in the Amazon or the middle of Borneo. But its effects are real, and increasingly, it's becoming a litmus test for how serious we are about sustainability, not just in words but in action.

Deforestation may feel distant, but its impact is anything but. The consequences are creeping into our everyday lives from the haze that chokes our cities to the rising food prices and extreme weather patterns we experience more frequently. The link between finance and forest destruction is becoming clearer, and the responsibility of financial institutions (FIs) in this ecosystem cannot be brushed aside. While bulldozers clear the land, someone is financing the machines. And increasingly, attention is turning to the FIs that enable these activities directly or indirectly by funding companies with deforestation-linked practices.

## **THE FOREST IS GONE, BUT WHO PAID FOR IT?**

Deforestation, simply put, is the large-scale clearing of forests for non-forest use. It is often done to make way for agriculture, plantations, logging operations or urban development. In tropical countries like Malaysia and Indonesia, this typically involves converting forests into palm oil estates, timber concessions or mining sites. But these are not just trees being lost. Forests are carbon sinks, biodiversity hubs, and cultural sanctuaries for indigenous peoples. When they go, climate emissions rise, species disappear, and communities are displaced.

Globally, we lose around 10 million hectares of forest annually, roughly the size of South Korea. Tropical deforestation is a leading contributor to greenhouse gas emissions in our region. What is less discussed, though, is how much of this destruction is made possible not by chainsaws but by capital from FIs.

FIs fuel these operations through loans, underwriting, investment, and credit lines. Without financing, large-scale forest clearing would be impossible. Whether knowingly or not, banks have long supported businesses that profit from forest degradation. A 2021 report by Global Witness found that FIs worldwide provided more than US\$157 billion in financing to companies with a high risk of

tropical deforestation between 2016 and 2020, including those based in Malaysia<sup>1</sup>.

## GREEN TALK OR GREENWASH?

So, what are FIs doing about it? Increasingly, regulators and investors are demanding more responsible behaviour. Here in Malaysia, Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) has taken the lead in pushing the financial sector toward better environmental risk management.

In April 2021, BNM introduced the Climate Change and Principle-based Taxonomy, or CCPT. This framework sets out five guiding principles (GPs) to assess how economic activities align with climate change objectives and promote a low-carbon economy. Based on the five GPs, economic activities will be classified into five categories. Activities causing significant harm to the environment and for which no remedial measures have been taken to reduce harm will be put under the "Watchlist" category by FIs.

### MSWG's questions to Bank Islam Malaysia Berhad

- 1) Please confirm the veracity of the news report whether the Bank extended the loan to the said company. If yes, what is the extent of the financing exposure to the entity involved?
- 2) Generally, what are the actions to be taken against customers who have been found that carried out Prohibited Activities under Bank Negara Malaysia's Climate Change and Principle-based Taxonomy (CCPT), or those who have caused significant negative environmental and social impacts throughout their operations?
- 3) Following BIMB's commitment to no new financing of coal-related activities since 2021, will the Bank establish a similar position in other high ESG risk industries, such as the palm oil industry, that has become the focal point of this controversy involving BIMB?

Under the CCPT, FIs must assess these risks before making lending decisions. But that is not all. In November 2022, BNM issued the Climate Risk Management and Scenario Analysis Policy Document, which sets out the principles and specific requirements for managing climate-related risks by financial institutions to enhance the financial sector's resilience against climate-related risks.

These guidelines urge FIs to look beyond short-term profits and consider the long-term consequences of their financing decisions, especially in high-risk sectors like forestry, agriculture and extractive industries.

BNM has also made its climate stance internationally known by joining the Network for Greening the Financial System, a global coalition of central banks and regulators. The message is clear: environmental and climate risks are now financial risks. And ignoring them is no longer an option.

## A DEAFENING SILENCE

Despite these regulatory frameworks, the practice on the ground can still fall short. A recent example involves Bank Islam Malaysia Berhad, one of Malaysia's leading Islamic financial institutions. An investigation piece published late 2024 alleged that Bank Islam had financed companies linked to deforestation activities

on peatland areas<sup>2</sup>. If true, these allegations raise serious environmental, reputational and governance concerns.

At Bank Islam's recent annual general meeting, MSWG raised several questions about this. We asked whether the allegations were factual. If they were baseless, would the bank take legal action against the media outlet that published them?

The Bank replied that it would not pursue legal action but did not confirm whether the claims were unfounded. Citing bank-client confidentiality, Bank Islam declined to disclose details about its exposure to companies allegedly involved in deforestation.

When asked whether it would adopt a clear and public "No Deforestation, No Peat, No Exploitation" (NDPE) policy, which has become a standard commitment for companies that wish to demonstrate environmental responsibility, the Bank did not give a firm answer.

The absence of clearer disclosures raises valid concerns. It suggests that while frameworks like CCPT exist, actual disclosure and accountability are still lagging in some FIs. Silence, in this case, speaks volumes. If the claims were false, why not clarify? If they were true, what corrective action would be taken? Without clear answers, stakeholders, investors, customers, and regulators are left in the dark.

## **WHY SHOULD SHAREHOLDERS CARE?**

At this point, you may be wondering why all this matters to shareholders. After all, isn't the primary concern whether the FI is making money?

The truth is that environmental risks are fast becoming financial risks. Companies involved in deforestation could face import bans, legal liabilities, and reputational damage. FIs that fund them may be exposed to defaults, stranded assets, or regulatory penalties. If

European regulators or US investors pull out due to deforestation concerns, the value of these companies and the loans attached to them could plummet. That hits the bottom line.

Furthermore, customers are paying attention. More Malaysians are asking how their money is used, especially in Islamic finance, which is premised upon Shariah principles, emphasising ethical and socially responsible practices. Younger consumers are making choices based on a bank's ESG profile. And global investors are scrutinising ESG disclosures more than ever before. The days of "don't ask, don't tell" are over.

## **WALKING THE TALK, NOT JUST TALKING THE TALK**

FIs must go beyond compliance and start leading. This means committing to the principle of responsible lending, phasing out financing to high-environmental and climate-risk economic activities, setting up proper due diligence systems, asking hard questions before financing high-risk projects, and being transparent with stakeholders. It means having the courage to walk away from deals that may be profitable in the short term but damaging in the long run.

We often hear the phrase "money talks." But what is it saying when it funds environmental destruction? When will it enable companies to raze forests, drain peatlands, and pollute rivers for short-term profit?

Banks wield enormous influence. With one decision, they can either greenlight deforestation or stop it. That is a responsibility they cannot outsource, hide from, or explain away. In a world where climate change is no longer a future threat but a present crisis, FIs must be part of the solution, not the problem.

And that starts with a simple principle: Stop funding deforestation.
